On November 17, 2009, the Board approved applicant's amended drawing. However, the Board did not address applicant's consented June 17, 2009 amendment to add a claim of color and to amend the description of the mark. Those amendments are also approved and entered.

Accordingly, the application is amended to add a claim of color and to state that "the colors Black and Cream are claimed as a feature of the mark." The description of the mark is amended to state "The mark consists of LITTLE DELIGHTS THE ORIGINAL COFFEE CUBE in black letters with Precolombian arabesque drawing and cream background."

The Board also notes that in view of the amended drawing to LITTLE DELIGHTS THE ORIGINAL COFFEE CUBE and design, the disclaimer will require an amendment to conform

with the amended drawing. Thus, applicant may amend the disclaimer to state "THE ORIGINAL COFFEE CUBE." Applicant's proposed amendment to the disclaimer should indicate that opposer has consented thereto.

In view thereof, applicant is allowed until THIRTY DAYS from the mailing date of this order to provide an amended disclaimer with an indication of opposer's consent.

Opposer's time to file a withdrawal of the opposition will be reset upon receipt of the amendment. Therefore, the Board's order of November 17, 2009 is vacated in part to the extent it required opposer to advise whether the dispute had been resolved and withdraw the opposition.

Proceedings herein remain otherwise suspended.
