Opposition Against "BARTENDER'S CHOICE", Serial no. 77/544324

As grounds of opposition, it is alleged that:

1. Opposer is the owner of U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,945,826 for the mark "ORIGINAL BARTENDERS COCKTAILS" for prepared alcoholic cocktails which was registered on the Principal Register on May 3, 2005. Said registration was based on an application filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on April 3, 2003, which is a date prior to the date of filing of Applicant's application of August 11, 2008. Opposer, since its first date of use of August 14, 1997, has continuously used and offered Opposer's goods bearing the mark "ORIGINAL BARTENDERS COCKTAILS" to the public through various channels of trade in commerce.
2. Said registered mark of Opposer is valid and subsisting and is prima facie evidence of Opposer's exclusive right to use said mark in commerce on the goods specified in said registration.
3. In view of the similarity of the respective marks and the related nature of the goods of the respective parties, it is alleged that Applicant's mark so resembles Opposer's registered mark, as to be likely to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive.
4. Opposer believes it will be damaged by the registration of Applicant's mark "BARTENDER'S CHOICE" in that the mark makes a confusing similar commercial impression to Opposer's "ORIGINAL BARTENDERS COCKTAILS" mark, and Applicant's mark will be used in connection with goods that are similar in nature to the goods offered to the public by Opposer.
5. Based on the similarities in the marks and the nature of the goods in issue, as well as the likely overlap in the channels of trade, the public is likely to be confused, mistaken or deceived as to the origin and sponsorship of Applicant's goods marketed under Applicant's mark and misled into believing such goods are produced by, emanate from, or are in some way directly or indirectly associated with Opposer, or that there exists some affiliation or relationship between Applicant and Opposer.

6. Based on the confusing similarities in commercial impression between Opposer's mark and Applicant's mark, Opposer believes that a likelihood of confusion will exist and Opposer will subsequently suffer damage and injury.

7. If Applicant is granted a registration for the mark "BARTENDER'S CHOICE" for the goods identified in application Serial No. 77/544324, it would obtain thereby at least prima facie exclusive right to use such mark. Such registration would be a source of damage and injury to Opposer.

WHEREFORE, Opposer prays that this Opposition be sustained in favor of Opposer; that Application Serial No. 77/544324 be rejected; and that registration of the mark therein sought be denied and refused.
