CONSENT MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEEDINGS

Pursuant to the Order dated November 29, 2012, the proceedings will resume on January 11, 2013. Opposer Wrangler Apparel Corp. and Applicant Hudson Clothing, LLC hereby jointly move for an additional 90-day suspension of the opposition proceeding. As requested by the Board in its Order dated November 29, 2012, the parties jointly submit the following detailed progress report in support of this request to suspend.


Subsequent to the filing of the last Consent Motion on November 9, 2012, the parties have had further communications via email on November 30, 2012, telephone conferences in December and most recently on January 7, 2013 and January 8, 2013 via email in an attempt to settle on terms of resolution. There are third party issues which have some impact on the settlement between the parties. Counsel are working to resolve these issues, including to effectuate a comprehensive resolution with said third parties. Unfortunately, due to the holiday

season, which is the most demanding on those in the apparel industry and the parties, it was difficult for counsel to bring the remaining issues to closure. Opposer Wrangler has submitted proposals to Applicant Hudson which, if accepted, would resolve the issues.

In view of the foregoing, the parties respectfully request that the Board grant this request to suspend the proceedings for an additional ninety (90) days so that the parties may continue their efforts to resolve the matter. The parties are not requesting an additional suspension to delay the proceedings but are requesting same so that good faith negotiations may continue.

Counsel for Opposer Wrangler Apparel Corp. secured the express consent of Applicant Hudson Clothing, LLC for the suspension requested herein on January 8, 2013. Applicant's counsel has agreed to service of the Consent Motion by electronic mail and U.S. First Class Mail.
