CONSENT MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEEDINGS

Pursuant to the Order dated April 19, 2013, the proceedings are suspended until October 11, 2013. Opposer Wrangler Apparel Corp. and Applicant Hudson Clothing, LLC hereby jointly move for an additional 120-day suspension of the opposition proceeding. As requested by the Board in its Order dated April 19, 2013, the parties jointly submit the following detailed progress report in support of this request to suspend.


Subsequent to the filing of the last Consent Motion on April 8, 2013, counsel for the parties discussed this matter and on April 16, 2013, a detailed email setting forth a proposal for resolution was exchanged. Counsel for the parties have had further discussions in June, 2013, August, 2013 and most recently exchanged emails on October 9, 2013, all related to terms of settlement. In addition, counsel for Opposer Wrangler has been advised that the general counsel for Wrangler has changed. The interim in-house counsel is now getting up to speed on

this proceeding. The parties wish to continue efforts to hopefully reach a comprehensive resolution and respectfully request the Board to consider the parties' exchanges on the terms of settlement as well as new in-house counsel's education and input on the matter.

In view of the foregoing, the parties respectfully request that the Board grant this request to suspend the proceedings for an additional one hundred twenty (120) days so that in-house counsel for Wrangler may review the issues and participate in meaningful discussions as well as allow counsel for the parties to continue their efforts to resolve the matter. The parties are not requesting an additional suspension to delay the proceedings but are requesting same so that good faith negotiations may continue.

Counsel for Opposer Wrangler Apparel Corp. secured the express consent of Applicant Hudson Clothing, LLC for the suspension requested herein on October 9, 2013. Applicant's counsel has agreed to service of the Consent Motion by electronic mail and U.S. First Class Mail.


