CONSENT MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEEDINGS

Pursuant to the Order dated November 20, 2013, the proceedings are suspended until April 12, 2014. Opposer Wrangler Apparel Corp. and Applicant Hudson Clothing, LLC hereby jointly move for an additional 120-day suspension of the opposition proceeding. As requested by the Board in its Order dated November 20, 2013, the parties jointly submit the following detailed progress report in support of this request to suspend.


Significant progress towards resolution has been achieved. Subsequent to the filing of the last Consent Motion on October 11, 2013, counsel for the parties discussed this matter these last several months, recently on April 4, 2014, wherein a follow-up detailed email setting forth a revised proposal for resolution was sent by counsel for Opposer Wrangler to counsel for Applicant Hudson Clothing. Counsel for Applicant advised that he needs additional time to review the proposed revised settlement with his client as well as obtain the input of in-

house counsel. The revised settlement, if accepted, will resolve the issues in this opposition as well as any third party issues which ultimately have an impact on any settlement between the parties. The parties wish to continue its efforts to reach a comprehensive resolution of the issues and respectfully request the Board to consider the parties' exchanges, including the recent revised settlement proposal, and allow the parties the additional time sought to attempt to resolve the issues.

In view of the foregoing, the parties respectfully request that the Board grant this request to suspend the proceedings for an additional one hundred twenty (120) days so that the parties may continue their efforts to resolve the matter. The parties are not requesting an additional suspension to delay the proceedings but are requesting same so that good faith negotiations may continue.

Counsel for Opposer Wrangler Apparel Corp. secured the express consent of Applicant Hudson Clothing, LLC for the suspension requested herein on April 4, 2014. Applicant's counsel has agreed to service of the Consent Motion by electronic mail and U.S. First Class Mail.


