Applicant then set a standard for how all Majestics Car Club cars would be built In 1997, applicant started the Majestics Car Club annual NEW YEARS DAY picnic which has become the largest custom car picnic annually in America.

3. In 1996 applicant was approached by Carol Strong for a request to make a documentary on the Majestics Car Club. As president over all the Majestics Car Club chapters Carol Strong was given permission by applicant to film the Majestics Car Club for the documentary. The documentary was completed in 2003 and was distributed by ROCK STAR VIDEO in 2004. That documentary along with U-TUBE video footage of applicant inspired many to want to become members of the Majestics Car Club which also inspired the addition of many new Majestics Car Club chapters. With Applicants approval.

4. Applicant was the first MAJESTICS CAR CLUB member to have his car grace the front cover of LOWRIDER magazine and WHEELS 2000 magazine. Applicants cars were in almost every edition of LOWRIDER and WHEELS 2000 magazines that were published which furthered the MAJESTICS CAR CLUBS name and reputation to the public. Applicant also revised the rules and regulations that all of the chapters abide by.

5. Applicant first used the MAJESTICS CAR CLUB name and logo in commerce in 1996 by promoting car shows, dances, car washes and selling MAJESTICS CAR CLUB T-shirts, caps and jackets. To applicants knowledge no one else has use the MAJESTICS CAR CLUB name and logo in commerce.

Applicant has a personal stake in the outcome of this opposition because applicant has made the MAJESTICS CAR CLUB known worldwide and has also set the standard for what the car club stands for and the prestige and respect the club is given thru out the world. Applicant has built the club for an unknown club with four chapters to a club known worldwide with 34 chapters. Applicant has dedicated his life to the club and everything that the applicant has done to enhance to clubs legacy has been positive. Applicant has a vision for the MAJESTICS CAR CLUB and has had a vision from the beginning when applicant first joined the club. It is applicants belief that if opposer prevails applicant will be damaged and so will the MAJESTICS CAR CLUB because opposer lacks the leadership, vision, and the respect that's required to maintain the level of quality, recognition and continued evolution that the MAJESTICS CAR CLUB is expiring too. Applicant does have a direct and personal stake in the outcome of this opposition. The MAJESTICS CAR CLUB is part of applicants' legacy and applicant's vision to form the club into a global corporation.

7. Applicants dedication and multiple contributions to the continuing evolution of the MAJESTICS CAR CLUB can't be disputed by opposer because even though opposer wasn't involved in anything in the last 20 years to contribute anything period to the club during the transformation of the MAJESTICS CAR CLUB from 4 to 34 chapters by applicant opposer knows that the club has made great strides forward under applicants leadership and guidance.
