

NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Miss Elaine, Inc., a Missouri Corporation, located and doing business at 8430 Valcour, St. Louis, Missouri 63123 (hereinafter “*Opposer*”) believes it would be damaged and injured by registration of the mark FASHIONABLY ME for “t-shirts, bathrobes; lingerie; nightgowns; nightshirts; pajamas; sleepwear; bras; boxer briefs; boxer shorts, panties, shorts and briefs; underwear; undergarments; undershirts; and underpants” in International Class 25, as shown in Application Serial No. 77/768,313, filed on June 25, 2009 by LF USA Inc. (hereinafter “*Applicant*”), and published on June 8, 2010 in the *Official Gazette for Trademarks*.

Opposer alleges, solely for the purpose of this proceeding, as grounds for opposition, the following:

1. Applicant filed Application Serial No. 77/768,313 for FASHIONABLY ME for “t-shirts, bathrobes; lingerie; nightgowns; nightshirts; pajamas; sleepwear; bras; boxer briefs; boxer shorts, panties, shorts and briefs; underwear; undergarments; undershirts; and underpants” in International Class 25, on June 25, 2009, claiming a date of first use use of the mark in commerce and interstate commerce as of January 31, 2009

under Section 1(a) of the Lanham Act, as evidenced by publication of said mark on June 8, 2010 in the *Official Gazette for Trademarks*.

2. Opposer is the owner of the following United States trademark registrations, among others:

3. Opposer is also the owner of common law rights in the marks listed above. The marks listed above and the corresponding common law marks are referred to hereinafter collectively as the “**ME Family of Marks**.” Opposer has used marks in the **ME Family of Marks** for more than 42 years.

4. Opposer is in the business of offering women's shirts, pants, loungewear, sleepwear, robes, dusters, shifts, sleepshirts, gowns, peignoirs, pajamas, bedjackets, jackets, caftans, nightshirts, dresses, jog suits, cover-ups and sportswear, namely, pullover tops, sweaters and jackets under the **ME Family of Marks**.

5. Opposer has prominently and extensively used, promoted and advertised the goods sold under its **ME** Family of Marks throughout the United States and in other parts of the world. By virtue of Opposer's efforts, the expenditure of considerable sums for promotional activities and the excellence of Opposer's goods, Opposer has gained a most valuable reputation in its **ME** Family of Marks.

6. Opposer's use and registration of its **ME** Family of Marks predate any date upon which Applicant can rely.

7. Upon information and belief, Applicant's intended use of and application for FASHIONABLY ME is intended to trade off of Opposer's goodwill in its **ME** Family of Marks.

8. Upon information and belief, Applicant's goods and Opposer's goods are likely to be sold, offered and/or used by the same class of purchasers.

9. Upon information and belief, Applicant's goods and Opposer's goods are likely to be offered, promoted and/or sold in the same channels of trade.

10. Opposer's **ME** Family of Marks are famous, and became famous prior to the filing date of Applicant's application and prior to Applicant's use of Applicant's mark captioned above. Opposer's **ME** Family of Marks are therefore entitled to a high degree and wide zone of protection. If Applicant's alleged trademark captioned above is allowed to register, such registration will dilute the distinctive quality of Opposer's famous **ME** Family of Marks.

11. Applicant's alleged mark "so resembles a mark registered in the Patent and Trademark Office, or a mark...previously used in the United States and not abandoned, as to be likely, when applied to the goods of the applicant, to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive." 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

12. If Applicant is permitted to use and register the alleged mark captioned above, confusion in trade resulting in damage and injury to Opposer would be caused and would result by reason of the confusingly similar nature of Applicant's alleged mark

captioned above and Opposer's **ME** Family of Marks. Furthermore any defect, misrepresentation, objection or fault found with Applicant's goods promoted under its alleged mark captioned above would necessarily reflect on and seriously injure the reputation that Opposer has established through use of its **ME** Family of Marks.

13. If Applicant is granted the registration herein opposed, it would thereby obtain at least a *prima facie* exclusive right to the use of its alleged mark. Such registration would be a source of further damage and injury to Opposer.


14. For the reasons set forth in the foregoing paragraphs, Applicant is not entitled to register its alleged mark and the application should be denied in accordance with Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1152 (d).

WHEREFORE, Opposer prays that Application Serial No. 77/768,313 be rejected, and that registration of Applicant's alleged mark shown and specified therein be refused and denied, that that this Opposition be sustained in favor of Opposer.

Opposer hereby gives notice under Rule 2.122(d) of the Trademark Rules of Practice that at hearing and in any appeal on this opposition proceeding, it will rely on Opposer's United States registrations as referenced above as evidence in support of this Notice of Opposition.
