This case comes up on opposer's consented motion (filed November 23, 2011) to suspend, and applicant's consented motion (filed November 28, 2011) to amend.

Suspension

Opposer's consented motion to suspend proceedings for thirty days is granted. Dates are reset on the schedule in the motion.

Amendment to Identification

Applicant seeks to amend the identification of goods in application Serial No. 77935615 to add the wording "in the field of computer-assisted communication between speakers of any language." The resulting goods would therefore be

medical communications systems in the field of computer-assisted communication between speakers of any language comprised of hand-held touch screen computers, head-mountable computers and software for providing interactive communication between the touch screen computers and the head mountable computers.

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If this resolves the dispute between the parties, opposer is allowed until thirty days from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c). Notwithstanding this thirty-day response period, dates are set as indicated above.

Amendment to Dates

The Board notes that applicant's earlier proposed amendment (filed January 26, 2011) to the dates of use remains deferred until final decision or until the case is decided upon summary judgment.

Should opposer withdraw the opposition, the motion to amend the dates of use will be granted without further delay. Alternatively, applicant may withdraw the motion to amend the dates of use.
