On May 23, 2011, opposer filed a motion to suspend for the parties' settlement discussions also advising that the parties had entered into a consent agreement, and that "suspension is needed to permit the USPTO Examining Attorney assigned to OPPOSER's corresponding trademark application (Serial No. 85028733) to consider the Agreement."
