**MOTION ON CONSENT TO SUSPEND PROCEEDING**

The parties hereby request a further ninety (90) day suspension of the subject Opposition. Counsel for Applicant agreed to the suspension on October 22, 2013. The parties are negotiating a worldwide settlement. The negotiations are being handled by European counsel of the respective parties. The undersigned has been in contact with her European counterpart who has advised as follows:

At the beginning of April, we have prepared a draft agreement on behalf of our client and discussed it with Rudolf Wild; on April 23, 2013 this draft agreement was sent to the representatives of The Wild Wolf Company S.L. in Alicante, Spain. On May 16, 2013, we corresponded with the other side’s attorneys on the scope of the application of the agreement and at the end of May, the other side’s attorney responded with a counter proposal for a global agreement. In July, the parties agreed on an amicable settlement of the pending proceedings in one agreement. In August 2013, we have been informed that the current representatives of the The Wild Wolf Company S.L would not be involved in the further negotiations in this matter but the legal department of the mother

company of the Wild Wolf Company S.L is now negotiating the agreement. On August 13, 2013, a concrete draft agreement on a global level has been presented by the other side and the parties are currently still discussing the details of this particular agreement. At this time, there are still unresolved issues remaining and the parties are presently involved in discussions in an attempt to resolve them.

Based on the foregoing, the parties have been and continue to be diligently trying to reach a resolution and therefore, the parties request a further ninety (90) day suspension.




