Applicant's consented motion (filed June 27, 2013) to suspend proceedings to accommodate the parties' ongoing efforts to settle this matter is granted. Proceedings herein are suspended subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time. See Trademark Rule 2.117(c).

If there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiation upon conclusion of the suspension period, proceedings shall resume automatically without further notice or order from the Board upon the schedule set forth in applicant's motion. Applicant is allowed until **August 29, 2013** in which to answer the notice of opposition.

IN EACH INSTANCE, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. See Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rule 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

If, during the suspension period, either of the parties or their attorneys should have a change of address, the Board should be so informed.¹
