However, initial disclosures, like requests for discovery, responses thereto, and materials or depositions obtained through the discovery process, should not be filed with the Board except when submitted (1) with a motion relating to discovery; or (2) in support of or response to a motion for summary judgment; or (3) under a notice of reliance during a party's testimony period; or (4) as exhibits to a testimony deposition; or (5) in support of an objection to proffered evidence on the ground that the evidence should

have been, but was not, provided in response to a request for discovery. See Trademark Rule 2.120(j)(8).

In view thereof, opposer is advised that the Board will give no further consideration to opposer's initial disclosures, filed February 21, 2012.
