NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

CareFusion 2200, Inc., (CareFusion) (hereinafter referred to as “Opposer”), a Delaware corporation having a principal place of business at 3750 Torrey View Court, San Diego, California 92130 believes that it will be damaged by registration of the above identified trademark application of CEP (hereinafter “Application”), in the name of Fitz Scientific, LLC, 2440 Avon Drive Mound Minnesota 55364 (hereinafter referred to as “Applicant”) for:

Medical apparatus, namely, handheld devices containing a foam swab for obtaining buccal cells in Intl. Class 10;

and hereby opposes registration of the same under the provisions of *Section 13 of the Trademark Act of July 5, 1946, 15 U.S.C. § 1063.*

As grounds therefor, it is alleged that:

1. CareFusion Corporation is a global company listed on the New York Stock Exchange (ticker symbol “CFN”) serving the healthcare industry with products and services designed to improve patient care, including the well-known products sold under the trademarks Pyxis®, Alaris®, V. Mueller®, Sepp® and others which are widely used in hospitals and all types of healthcare facilities throughout the United States.

2. CareFusion 2200, Inc. is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business at 3750 Torrey View Court, San Diego, California 92130, and is a wholly-owned subsidiary of CareFusion Corporation. CareFusion 2200, Inc. is the owner of the registered SEPP trademark, Registration Number 1,075,364.

3. Opposer is the owner of the trademark SEPP, the United States Trademark Registrations thereof, and the goodwill symbolized by the trademark and the registration thereof, as follows:

SEPP - Registration No. 1075364, registered October 18, 1977, for unitary antiseptic scrub solution sold with applicator.

A copy of the above registration numbers with TESS and Assignment print-outs, showing record title in Opposer, is attached as Exhibit 1.

4. The certificate of registration identified in paragraph 3 is valid and subsisting; the certificates of registration are *prima facie* evidence of the validity of the registrations, the Applicant’s ownership of the mark, and of the Opposer’s exclusive right to use the mark in commerce in connection with the goods specified in the certificates of registration under the provisions of 15 U.S.C. § 1057(b), and constructive notice of the Opposers’ claim of ownership under 15 U.S.C. § 1072. The registration is incontestable, which provides conclusive evidence

of its validity, Opposer's ownership of the mark and Opposer's exclusive right to use the mark in commerce under 15 U.S.C. § 1115(b).

5. Opposer and Applicant are competitors in the marketplace for the sale of medical and health care related products and services.

6. Opposer's SEPP mark and Applicant's CEP mark are identical in sound and similar in appearance.

7. Upon information and belief, there are no restrictions in the goods descriptions of Applicant's application, so that it must be presumed that Applicant's CEP goods are offered to and used by some of the same medical and health care customers and consumers who would also be in the market for and use Opposer's SEPP products.

8. Upon information and belief, Applicant's CEP medical goods are advertised, marketed, promoted and provided through the same channels of trade, are advertised in the same types of media as Opposer's SEPP goods, and are sold to the same classes of the purchasing public for use by or on the same consumers as Opposer's SEPP products.

9. The designation CEP that the Applicant seeks to register is highly similar to Opposer's SEPP trademark, and consumers and potential customers will believe that CEP goods are connected with, affiliated with or endorsed by the owner of Opposer's products and services and Opposer's SEPP trademark, or that the CEP goods are a new line of goods or services of Opposer. Applicant's CEP product is a foam applicator product for use on humans to obtain buccal cells and Opposer's SEPP product is an antiseptic swab product that is used on humans.

10. Opposer, since long prior to Applicant's alleged first use date of January 1, 2009 set out in Applicant's application of CEP for

Medical apparatus, namely, handheld devices containing a foam swab for obtaining buccal cells in Intl. Class 10,

has spent, and continues to spend, large sums of money in the advertisement, marketing, promotion of its trademark SEPP and the sale of its goods identified and distinguished by its SEPP trademark, and by reason of such advertising, promotion, marketing and the high quality of its products and services carrying the SEPP trademark, Opposer now enjoys a valuable goodwill and an enviable reputation with respect to its SEPP trademark.

11. The distinctive and arbitrary trademark "SEPP" is not used by any other entity in the health care or medical care products business, and has attained widespread public recognition and has acquired great value in its identification as trademark, and of the source of goods in or by Opposer and its distributors, and the said SEPP trademark distinguishes Opposer and its goods from the goods of others.

12. The use and registration of the CEP mark by the Applicant will cause the purchasing public and those who use or are familiar with Opposer's goods to assume, erroneously, and to be confused, misled and/or deceived, that the Applicant's CEP mark and goods are made by or originate with, are licensed by, endorsed or sponsored by, or are in some other way associated or connected with Opposer, all to Opposer's great injury and irreparable damage.

13. For the reasons set forth in paragraphs 1 through 12, Opposer believes, and in so believing asserts, that the goodwill in its distinctive SEPP trademark will be damaged under

Section 2(d) and that the Applicant's application for the mark CEP in Intl. Class 10 should be denied.

14. By reason of the foregoing, Applicant's application of CEP in Intl. Class 10 is likely to cause confusion with the Opposer's trademark SEPP for related medical products, and is thus not registrable under *Section 13 of the Trademark Act of 1946 (15 U.S.C. § 1063)*.

WHEREFORE, Opposer prays that this Opposition be sustained and that Application Serial No. 85/331951 for Applicant's trademark CEP be refused registration.

The fee of \$300.00 for this Opposition, as provided by *Sections 13 and 31 of the Trademark Act of 1946* is paid by charging Opposer's attorneys' credit card.
