**Lalita Greer, Paralegal Specialist:**

Opposer's motion filed June 30, 2014, to further suspend this proceeding for an additional sixty 60 days to allow parties time to continue their settlement negotiations is granted as uncontested.<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, proceedings herein remain suspended for sixty days, subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time. See Trademark Rule 2.117(c).

In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations, upon conclusion of the suspension period, proceedings shall resume without further notice or order from the Board, upon the schedule set out in opposer's motion.

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<sup>1</sup> The parties are reminded that there is a continuing obligation to provide good cause in the form of detailed progress reports for any further extension or suspension requests. Failing, which the request to further extend or suspend may be denied even if consented to by both parties.

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rule 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

If, during the suspension period, either of the parties or their attorneys should have a change of address, the Board should be so informed.
