Opposer's consented motion filed November 19, 2012, to suspend proceedings is granted. Because the parties are negotiating for a possible settlement of this case, proceedings herein are suspended until **February 21, 2013**, subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time. See Trademark Rule 2.117(c).

In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations, upon conclusion of the suspension period, proceedings shall resume without further notice or order from the Board, upon the schedule set out below.

Applicant is allowed **THIRTY DAYS** from resumption in which to answer the **notice of opposition**. The parties are allowed the same THIRTY DAYS in which to serve responses to any outstanding discovery requests.
