Applicant's consented motion (filed March 10, 2014) to maintain suspension of this proceeding for an additional 180 days so that the parties may finalize settlement is **GRANTED** for good cause shown based upon the status report submitted concurrently with the consented motion to suspend.¹

Accordingly, proceedings remain suspended up to, and including, **September 10, 2014**, subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time. *See* Trademark Rules 2.117(c), and 2.127(a); and TBMP § 605.02.

¹ The Board notes that the status report indicates that the parties have already executed a settlement agreement but require additional suspension of this matter because opposer is pursuing its own registration and needs to respond to an outstanding Office Action to effectuate the terms of the parties' settlement agreement.

In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations, upon conclusion of the suspension period, proceedings shall resume without further notice or order from the Board, upon the schedule set forth below.

Applicant is allowed until the time set forth below from resumption in which to answer the notice of opposition. Conferencing, disclosure, discovery and trial dates are reset as follows:

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony, together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rules 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

If, during the suspension period, either of the parties or their attorneys should have a change of address, the Board should be so informed.²

As a final matter, if the parties request any further requests to suspend and extend for settlement, they must provide a supplemental status report with the request to extend or suspend for settlement pursuant to the guidelines set forth in the Board's December 11, 2013, order.

² If the parties are (or during the pendency of this proceeding become) parties to another proceeding involving the subject application/registration, the parties must notify the Board so the Board can consider whether consolidation or suspension of proceedings is appropriate.
