Applicant's consented motion (filed November 25, 2013) to extend time to file its answer to the notice of opposition and to extend conferencing, disclosure, discovery and trial dates is noted.

By order dated November 6, 2013, the Board, *inter alia*, advised the parties that if they sought another request to extend or suspend for settlement they would be required to submit a status report of their settlement negotiations pursuant to the guidelines set forth in the order.

Applicant's November 25, 2013, consented motion to extend does not provide the required status report.

In view thereof, applicant's November 25, 2013, consented motion to extend is **DENIED**.

Applicant's answer remains due by **December 21, 2013**. Remaining trial dates remain as reset by the Board's November 6, 2013, order.

As a final matter, to the extent the parties file another consented motion to extend or suspend for settlement, the parties should not employ the Board's ESTTA "consented motions" form; instead, the parties should utilize the "general filings" form and provide a proposed trial schedule, as well as the required status report.
