On August 23, 2013, the parties filed a stipulated motion proposing amendment to the identification of goods in application Serial No. 85524287, and opposer's withdrawal of the opposition, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment, applicant seeks to amend the identification in International Class 025 to add the following underlined language:

Hats; pants; shirts; all the foregoing for use in connection with increasing awareness of and teaching others about The Right Hand Deliverance Evangelistic Center and five fold ministry.

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer consents, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

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The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having been met, the opposition is dismissed in accordance with the agreement between the parties.
