History:

Irving Earl Dunn, Sr. came to the knowledge of Jesus Christ in the month of June 1981, under the leadership of Apostle Willie S. Darden, Pastor and Founder then of Maranatha Deliverance Evangelistic Center, now of The Word of God Deliverance Evangelistic Church, Inc. 271/100 Plant Street, Enfield, North Carolina 27823. In 1960's and 1970's, Apostle Willie S. Darden resided in Paterson, New Jersey serving as Pastor of The Paterson Deliverance Evangelistic Center, with a membership of 300 and growing under the leadership of the Late Apostle Arthro Skinner. After receiving a confirmation from the Lord, Apostle Skinner sent Apostle Darden south to fulfill his calling as a shepherd and an Apostle to preach deliverance with the blessings of the Lord in the land where God will direct him to go. The legacy of our Formal pastor and overseer (Apostle Arthro Skinner) known as the "Father of Deliverance" in the Pentecostal circles, founded the Deliverance Evangelistic Center of Brooklyn, New York in the 1950's and founded other churches or centers in cities such as Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Newark, New Jersey, and other large and small cities up and down the East Coast. Skinner's ministry, which Pentecostal in nature, focused on salvation and divine healing. There was also a strong element of the prophetic in Skinner's ministry and in the ministries of the Evangelists and other clergies who received Ecclesiastical training at this center.

Irving Earl Dunn, Sr. is an ordained Minister having been called of God and recommended by the Board of Presbytery, has been this day set apart, by the laying on of hands of prayer, to the office and work of a minister of the Gospel in the church of God, so long as his life and doctrine shall conform to the Holy Scriptures. He is hereby authorized to perform the duties consistent with this office of doing the work of Pastor and Evangelist in working full proof of his ministry. Done this Thirtieth day of May in the year of Our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety,-Three.

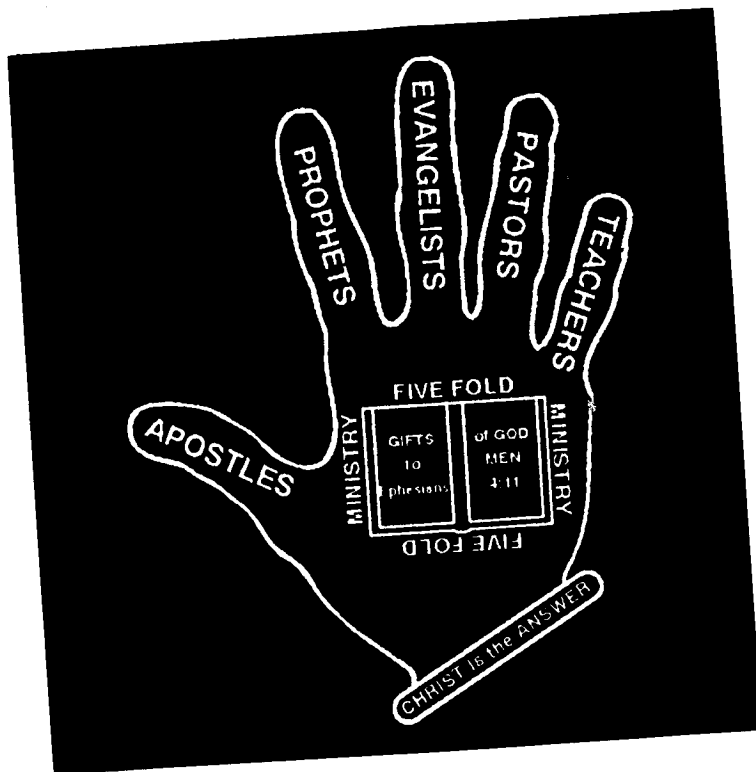
May 26-30, 1993, we had our grand opening of The Right Hand Deliverance Evangelistic Center; a new ministry was born under the leadership of the Apostle and Overseer Willie S. Darden, 607 Fire Tower Road, LaGrange, North Carolina. In June 1993 God began to deal with me concerning the work of the ministry and the use of the right hand. That same year (June 1993) I, Pastor Irving Earl Dunn, Sr. created a bumper sticker for the ministry which was first used in commerce. In the same year I was informed to use the modern Poor Man's copyright by putting these drawings of my own right hand with scripture verses sealing them in an envelope. Using the method of registered dating by the Postal Services in which I still have today, which is dated (June 15, 1993) which the seal has never been broken to this day (December 5, 2012).

The right hand is not only a symbol, but Vision, Ministry, Gifts, and Offices of the Five Fold; working in the vineyard winning and better lives for Christ. The duties of the ordained clergyman are precise and demanding. The Deliverance Manual has been designed to acquaint the Minister with certain facts, and lay before him organized patterns of collective procedures accepted and recommended by the Trustee Board of Deliverance Evangelistic Centers, Incorporated.
