The Commissioner for Trademarks has approved the acceptance of a letter of protest that was filed as to the above-identified trademark application. The letter of protest presented evidence that would support a likelihood of confusion refusal under Trademark Act Section 2(d) with respect to the mark FLOSSY in U.S. Registration No. 3524902. 15 U.S.C. §1052(d).
