In response to the Board's order dated April 22, 2015, Applicant's motion for acceptance of stipulated extension of time to answer filed April 23, 2015 is accepted and retroactively granted.

Applicant's consented motion filed May 8, 2015 to extend time to file an answer to the notice of opposition and to extend conference, disclosure, discovery and trial dates is granted. See Trademark Rule 2.127(a).

Answer is due June 9, 2015. The conference, disclosure, discovery and trial dates are reset in accordance with Applicant's motion.

The parties are reminded that there is a continuing obligation to provide a report on the progress of the parties' settlement efforts to establish good cause for any further extension or suspension. Such report must include: a recitation of

issues that have been resolved and issues that remain to be resolved, and a firm timetable for resolution. Absent such a report, any future motion to extend or suspend may not be approved, even though agreed to by the parties.

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. See Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rules 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.
