On March 5, 2015, Applicant filed a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 86119776, with Opposer's consent.

By the proposed amendment Applicant seeks to amend the identification of goods in International Class 9.

From Air quality measurement apparatus, namely, particle counters; Electronic-based instruments for measuring environmental parameters including humidity, mold, bacteria, air quality and water quality; Environmental monitoring system comprised of meters and sensors that measure pressure, humidity, temperature and includes alarm and reporting functions

To Air quality measurement apparatus not for use in connection with clean rooms, namely, particle counters; Electronic-based instruments for measuring environmental parameters including humidity, mold, bacteria, air quality and water quality; Environmental monitoring system comprised of meters and sensors that measure pressure, humidity, temperature and includes alarm and reporting functions

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because Opposer consents thereto, the amendment is approved and entered. *See* Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If the amendment resolves this proceeding, Opposer is allowed until thirty days from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. *See* Trademark Rule 2.106(c).

If no response is filed, proceedings will be resumed and dates reset, as appropriate.

Proceedings are otherwise suspended.
