On June 25, 2015, Applicant filed an abandonment of its application Serial No. 86291830 with prejudice.

Trademark Rule 2.135 provides that if, in an inter partes proceeding, the Applicant files an abandonment without the written consent of every adverse party to the proceeding, judgment shall be entered against Applicant. However, inasmuch as Applicant has stated that the abandonment was with Opposer consent pursuant to the parties settlement agreement, the Board will allow Applicant an opportunity to submit Opposer's written consent.

In view thereof, Applicant is allowed twenty days from the mailing date of this order in which to submit Opposer's written consent to the abandonment, failing which judgment will be entered against Applicant, and the opposition will be sustained.
