The grounds for the notice are as follows:

1. Opposer is a subsidiary of Elite World SA, a leading global model management company. Since 1998, Opposer has licensed the ELITE brand for use on a variety of goods and services, including but not limited to hair, beauty, and cosmetics accessories and tools, and related products.

2. Opposer owns, *inter alia*, U.S. trademark Registration No. 4725715 for ELITE, in the stylized form shown below:



Opposer's Registration No. 4725715 covers numerous goods and services, including the following (among others):

No. 2258352 (ELITE MODELS FASHION), for a variety of clothing, fashion, and beauty goods and services (collectively, with the ELITE Mark, the "ELITE Marks").
- 4. By reason of Opposer's investment of time, money and effort, Opposer's ELITE Marks have come to be recognized as signifying Opposer and its products. Opposer has built up extensive goodwill in its ELITE Marks.

- 5. Long prior to Applicant's filing of its application to register the mark "ELIE" and prior to any use of the applied-for mark by Applicant, purchasers had come to recognize Opposer's ELITE Marks as identifying goods and services emanating exclusively from Opposer.
- 6. Notwithstanding Opposer's prior rights in and to Opposer's ELITE Marks, on April 15, 2015, Applicant filed U.S. Serial No. 86598400 for the mark "ELIE" for the following goods in International Classes 8 and 11:

Instead, the holder must file a renewal of the underlying international registration at the International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization, under Article 7 of the Madrid Protocol, before the expiration of each ten-year term of protection, calculated from the date of the international registration.
