JOINT MOTION TO AMEND APPLICATION AND NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

Applicant, with Opposer's consent, hereby amends its description of goods for its U.S.

Trademark Application Serial No. 79/172,418 to read as follows:

1. **Class 9**: "Computer software and downloadable mobile applications for providing reference information and data access for education and business support for use in the fields of international trade and business, including banking and financial services, of policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes and guidelines for business and international trade, and of alternative dispute resolution; electronic publications, namely, e-books, audio and visual presentations, and films, in electronic form, recorded on data carriers, or downloadable on-line from a computer database or the Internet; all the aforesaid in the fields of international trade and business, including banking and financial services, of policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes, and guidelines for business and international trade, and of alternative dispute resolution; excluding codes, rules and guidelines relating to building and construction, and to building and construction safety"
2. **Class 16**: "Printed publications, namely, books, magazines, newsletters, bulletins, posters reports, guides, codes, rules, policy papers, research papers in the fields of international trade and business, including banking and financial services, of policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes and guidelines for business and international trade, and of alternative dispute resolution; photographs, printed and instructional and teaching materials in the fields of international trade and business, including banking and financial services, of policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes, and guidelines for business and international trade, and of alternative dispute resolution; excluding codes, rules and guidelines relating to building and construction, and to building and construction safety"

3. **Class 35**: “Business research, advisory and consulting services in the fields of international trade and business, of policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes, and guidelines for business and international trade, and of alternative dispute resolution; computer database compilation; business advisory services namely, provision of business information using databases of businesses and business services and business database services to facilitate the forming of business relationships online or using the internet; organisation of exhibitions for business and trade purposes; conducting business surveys, opinion polls, economic forecasts; market studies and research; business information services relating to international trade and business, to policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes, and guidelines for business and international trade, and to alternative dispute resolution; excluding codes, rules and guidelines relating to building and construction, and to building and construction safety”
4. **Class 41**: “Educational and training services, namely, distance learning and on-line education and training services in the fields of international trade and business, banking and financial services, policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes and guidelines for business and international trade, and alternative dispute resolution; providing seminars, courses and conferences, and organization of examinations and certification of education and training, in the fields of international trade and business, banking and financial services, policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes and guidelines for business and international trade, and alternative dispute resolution; organization of competitions, and providing recognition and incentives in the form of prizes and awards, for excellence in the fields of international trade and business, banking and financial services, policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes and guidelines for business and international trade, and alternative dispute resolution; production of audio, video and film recordings; writing and publication of books, journals and texts, in any medium, including in electronic form; providing non-downloadable on-line electronic publications, namely, books, magazines, newsletters, bulletins, posters, reports, guides, codes, rules, policy papers and research papers in the fields of international trade and business, banking and financial services, policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes and guidelines for business and international trade, and alternative dispute resolution; providing information in the fields of education and training; excluding codes, rules and guidelines relating to building and construction, and to building and construction safety”
5. **Class 42**: “Accreditation of trainers and training courses, namely, developing, evaluating, and testing standards for education and training services for the purpose of accreditation; computer software and mobile applications development in the fields of international trade and business, including banking and financial services, of policy development, self-regulatory rules, codes, and guidelines for business and international trade, and of alternative dispute resolution; excluding codes, rules and guidelines relating to building and construction, and to building and construction safety”

Contingent upon the acceptance of the above-stated amendments, Opposer hereby voluntarily dismisses the above-captioned action with prejudice.
