By the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board:

On November 9, 2016, Applicant filed a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 86729498, with Opposer's written consent, and Opposer's withdrawal of the opposition with prejudice, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment, Applicant seeks to amend the identification of goods in International Class 25 as follows:¹

From: Apparel, namely, jackets, caps, hats, T-shirts, shirts, polo shirts, tank tops, sweatshirts, hooded sweatshirts, and children's rompers,

To: Apparel, namely, jackets, caps, hats, T-shirts, shirts, polo shirts, tank tops, sweatshirts, hooded sweatshirts, and children's rompers, **for use in the promotion of applicant's boating and watercraft products.**

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because Opposer consents thereto, the amendment is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

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The contingency in Opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed with prejudice in accordance with the agreement between the parties.

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
