NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

BattleBots, Inc. (“BattleBots” or “Opposer”), a California corporation with its principal place of business at Building 140, 1024 Nimitz Avenue, Mare Island, Vallejo, California, 94592, believes that it will be damaged by the registration of the mark shown in Application Serial No. 87/646,921 (the “Opposed Mark”) and therefore opposes registration of the same under Section 13 of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1063. The grounds for opposition are as follows:

1. BattleBots is an entity that has been engaged in, among other things, the development, production, and licensing of television shows, toy robots and battling robots, and other merchandise, and has built a successful business in connection therewith. Since at least as early as December 7, 2000, Opposer has used BATTLEBOTS trademarks in connection with its goods and services. As such, BattleBots is the owner of a family of marks comprised of the word BATTLEBOTS that identify and distinguish its goods and services in commerce.

2. Examples of the extent of Opposer’s use of its BATTLEBOTS names and marks can be seen at its website, www.battlebots.com, and includes, but is not limited to, television

programs delivered by cable and broadcast television and the Internet, toys, clothing, and various other licensed merchandising programs. Opposer has authorized merchandising deals with prominent toy companies, and its products are currently distributed through, *inter alia*, Amazon.com, Walmart, and on the BattleBots website at <http://store.battlebots.com/>.

3. In 2014, ABC picked up the BATTLEBOTS television show. From 2015-2016, ABC aired a revival series of the show and featured the show for two seasons. In 2017, the Science Channel picked up and aired repeats of the show. This year, the BATTLEBOTS television show will be carried on both the Science and Discovery Channels for its third revival series. In addition, numerous seasons of the BATTLEBOTS television show have aired on Comedy Central, and seasons of the show have been and are now being syndicated to over 150 countries internationally.

4. BattleBots also is the owner of U.S. registrations in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (“USPTO”) for the following marks (collectively, the “Marks”):

5. True and correct copies of registrations for the above Marks and TSDR records showing current status and title are attached hereto as Exhibit A, and are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein.

6. All of BattleBots' registrations identified above are valid and subsisting and *prima facie* evidence of the validity thereof and of BattleBots' ownership and exclusive right to use the Marks in commerce, and are constructive notice of BattleBots' ownership thereof, all as provided by Sections 7(b) and 22 of the Lanham Act. In addition, U.S. Reg. Nos. 2,731,171 and 2,756,698 are incontestable as to all goods and/or services listed therein under Section 15 of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1065, meaning that the registrations are conclusive evidence of Opposer's exclusive right to the registered marks in commerce on, or in connection with, the goods or services stated in the registrations, as provided by Section 33(b) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1115(b).

7. BattleBots has expended considerable funds and made significant efforts in promoting and advertising BattleBots' goods and services identified by the Marks. These goods and services have enjoyed enormous commercial success and have been the subject of substantial, unsolicited media attention. As a result, BattleBots has established an enviable reputation with the public, acquired substantial goodwill, and attained distinctiveness and fame in each of the Marks throughout the entire United States.

8. Opposer has accumulated extensive goodwill in connection with, *inter alia*, the exhibition of robotic contests for the general public, for corporate events, and through licensing to non-profit education organizations, and the sale of its goods bearing this mark, and this goodwill is an important asset of its business and very valuable to it.

9. Indeed, Opposer's business under its Marks is not only limited to the United States, but has been international in scope since prior to October 16, 2017. Opposer maintains multiple valid trademark registrations in at least twenty-one (21) other countries, including Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, the European Union, Hong Kong, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, New Zealand, Norway, the Philippines, the Russian Federation, Singapore, South Korea, Switzerland, Thailand, Taiwan, and Turkey.

10. As a result of BattleBots' widespread use of the Marks in the United States and worldwide, extensive advertising and promotion, continuous and unsolicited media coverage, the high degree of consumer recognition of the Marks, and the strong and loyal base of customers who enjoy BattleBots' goods and services, among other factors, the Marks are famous within the meaning of Section 43(c) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c).

11. BattleBots' rights in the Marks notwithstanding, on October 16, 2017, Applicant Kenneth Grimm ("Applicant" or "Grimm") filed with the USPTO an intent-to-use trademark application designated as Application Serial No. 87/646,921 which seeks to register the mark COMBAT BOTS for: "[e]ducational services, namely, conducting programs that provide training courses and classes in the field of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) for students and providing curricula in connection therewith; [e]ducational competitions for students in the field of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) featuring robots" in International Class 41 (herein "the Opposed Application").

12. The Opposed Application was published for opposition in the *Trademark Official Gazette* on March 13, 2018. BattleBots timely filed an extension of the opposition period to May 12, 2018.

**FIRST GROUND FOR OPPOSITION:
LIKELIHOOD OF CONFUSION**

13. BattleBots incorporates by reference Paragraphs 1 through 12, inclusive, as if fully set forth herein.

14. BattleBots began using the Marks at least as early as December 7, 2000, and filed applications resulting in federal registrations for the Marks well prior to when Applicant filed the Opposed Application.

15. The Marks are strong and famous.

16. BattleBots' use and/or constructive use rights for the Marks are prior to any rights of Applicant to the COMBAT BOTS mark and have been continuous and extremely commercially significant.

17. Applicant is not affiliated with or sponsored by BattleBots, and has never been authorized by BattleBots to use the Marks in any form.

18. In view of the similarities between, on the one hand, each of the Marks, and, on the other hand, the COMBAT BOTS mark that is the subject of the Opposed Application, and the relationship between BattleBots' goods and services as identified by the Marks and the services identified in the Opposed Application, it is likely that members of the public will erroneously believe that Applicant's services originate with, or are in some manner connected or associated with, or sponsored by, BattleBots, all to the harm of BattleBots' goodwill and reputation.

19. Applicant's COMBAT BOTS mark so resembles each of the Marks when used on, or in connection with, Applicant's services as to be likely to cause confusion, mistake or to deceive, and is therefore precluded from registration under Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

**SECOND GROUND FOR OPPOSITION:
DILUTION OF A FAMOUS MARK**

20. BattleBots incorporates by reference Paragraphs 1 through 19, inclusive, as if fully set forth herein.

21. The Marks are inherently distinctive as an identifier of the source of BattleBots' goods and services and have been in widespread and exclusive use by BattleBots in the United States and internationally for well over a decade.

22. BattleBots has broadly promoted the Marks, and BattleBots' goods and services offered under the Marks have received extensive media attention.

23. As a result of the enormous publicity afforded the Marks, and the strong and loyal base of customers who enjoy BattleBots' goods and services, the Marks have a high degree of consumer recognition, are widely recognized by the general consuming public of the United States as a designation of BattleBots' good and services, and are famous.

24. The Marks became famous before Applicant applied to register the COMBAT BOTS mark on October 16, 2017.

25. In view of the fame of each of the Marks, and that this fame preceded any of Applicant's rights in its mark, Applicant's COMBAT BOTS mark will lessen the capacity of Opposer's famous Marks to identify and distinguish Opposer's goods and services, and is therefore likely to dilute Opposer's Marks. Accordingly, registration is therefore also precluded under 13(a) and 43(c) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1063(a), and 1125(c), respectively.

26. If Applicant is granted registration of the COMBAT BOTS mark, it would cause damage and injury to BattleBots, *inter alia*, because Applicant would obtain a wrongful *prima facie* exclusive right to use of its COMBAT BOTS mark.

WHEREFORE, BattleBots respectfully requests that this Opposition be granted, and that Application Serial No. 87/646,921 be denied registration.
