MOTION ON CONSENT TO SUSPEND FOR SETTLEMENT

This motion is not brought for purposes of delay. Opposer respectfully submits that there is good cause for suspension and makes this request to allow the parties to continue negotiating the terms of settlement.

Throughout the course of this proceeding, the parties have exchanged a series of settlement proposals and counter-proposals via email and telephone. The parties appear to be close to reaching agreement on the proposed terms of settlement, but need additional time in order to finalize the agreement on the terms of settlement. Since the last Consent Motion for Suspension for Settlement filed on December 15, 2021 (which the Board granted on February 15, 2022), the parties have continued their good faith efforts to attempt to amicably resolve this matter. On February 2, 2022, the parties agreed on filing a stipulated request for a further suspension of the opposition to afford sufficient time to attempt to finalize the terms of an amicable resolution to this matter, the terms of which are confidential.

The Board has requested a proposed timetable for final resolution. The parties are hopeful they will be able to reach an amicable resolution in this matter within the coming weeks, though it is difficult to predict an exact timeframe for final resolution.

Opposer respectfully requests that the Board grant this consent motion and suspend the opposition for 60 days.
