NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Opposer Compassion International, Inc., an Illinois non-profit corporation with an address of 12290 Voyager Parkway, P.O. Box 65000, Colorado Springs, Colorado 80962 (“Opposer”) believes that it will be damaged by registration of the mark shown in U.S. Serial No. 88/196,675, and hereby opposes the same under the provisions of 15 U.S.C. § 1063. As grounds for opposition, Opposer asserts the following:

1. Founded in 1966, Opposer is an internationally known Christian child development organization assisting over one million children in the United States and across the globe. Opposer provides these charitable assistance services in a variety of fields, including educational, medical, food, counseling, and spiritual assistance. The popularity of Opposer and its goods and services is reflected in its social media following. Opposer’s Instagram account features over 138,000 followers, and followers of its Twitter account number over 212,000. Exhibit A features screenshots of the front pages of these accounts.

2. In connection with these goods and services, and to promote its charitable and non-profit missions through its official partnerships with third parties, Opposer has adopted and long and continuously used certain marks in standard character, stylized, and/or word and design fashion, including but not limited to COMPASSION, COMPASSION INTERNATIONAL, COMPASSION SUNDAY, COMPASSION EXPLORER, SPEAK UP WITH COMPASSION, STEP UP WITH COMPASSION, and ACT FOR COMPASSION (the “COMPASSION Marks”). The COMPASSION Marks have long been a source identifier for Compassion International and the Compassion International Services.


3. Opposer’s COMPASSION Marks are inherently distinctive, serving to identify and indicate the source of Opposer’s goods and services to the consuming public, and to distinguish Opposer’s goods and services from those of others.

4. Additionally, as a result of Opposer’s use and promotion of its COMPASSION Marks, the marks are widely recognized by consumers as distinctive. Opposer has invested significant effort and resources in advertising and promoting its COMPASSION Marks and the goods and services offered under those marks, with the result that the purchasing public has come to know, rely on, and recognize the goods and services of Opposer by those marks. Opposer has established valuable goodwill in its COMPASSION Marks.

5. In addition to its extensive common law rights, Opposer owns numerous federal trademark registrations covering the COMPASSION Marks, including but not limited to the following:

Each registration listed in the chart above is valid and subsisting and constitutes conclusive and/or *prima facie* evidence of the validity of the mark and registration, of Opposer’s ownership of and exclusive right to use the mark in commerce, and provides constructive notice of Opposer’s trademark rights.

6. CompassionUS Inc., a Maryland corporation with an address of 4843 Vicky Road, Nottingham, Maryland 21236 (“Applicant”) filed U.S. Serial No. 88/196,675 on November 16, 2018 on a Section 1(a) in-use basis with a first use date in commerce of October 16, 2018 for the following Class 35 services: Charitable services in the nature of coordination of the procurement and distribution of food donations from the general public to needy persons; Charitable services in the nature of matching philanthropists with nonprofit organizations and causes in the field of drug and alcohol addiction, gun violence, fatherlessness, educational reform, domestic violence, homelessness, sex trafficking, racial reconciliation, media accountability, prison reform, mental

7. Opposer has priority based on its prior use and registration of its COMPASSION Marks in the United States.

8. Applicant’s Services are identical, nearly identical, or highly related to the goods and services for which Opposer has long used and registered its COMPASSION Marks.

9. Upon information and belief, Applicant's Services will travel in the same or similar channels of trade as Opposer's goods and services, and will be purchased and/or used by the same or similar types of consumers who purchase and use Opposer's goods and services.

10. Opposer has not given Applicant permission or approval to use or register the mark COMPASSIONUS.

11. Applicant's COMPASSIONUS mark is nearly identical to Opposer's COMPASSION Marks and will be seen as uniquely and unmistakably identifying Applicant and its goods and services.

12. Applicant's COMPASSIONUS mark so resembles Opposer's COMPASSION Marks as to be likely, when used in connection with the services identified in the Application, to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive. Registration of Applicant's COMPASSIONUS mark therefore should be refused under 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

13. Registration of Applicant's COMPASSIONUS mark on the Principal Register would damage Opposer because it would confer upon Applicant statutory presumptions to which Applicant is not entitled in view of Opposer's longstanding prior use and registration of its COMPASSION Marks.

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WHEREFORE, Opposer prays that U.S. Serial No. 88/196,675 be rejected, and that registration of the mark therein be refused.

This Notice of Opposition is being filed electronically, along with the filing fee required by 37 C.F.R. § 2.6.(a)(17). The Commissioner is authorized to draw on the Deposit Account of Pirkey Barber PLLC, Account No. 50-3924/CPAS5001/SLE, if there is any problem with the processing of the electronically submitted fee.
