Applicant's motion (filed October 11, 2019) to suspend this proceeding pending final determination of Civil Action No. 3:19-cv-0722-S, styled *Horizon AG-Products, LP v. Verdesian Life Sciences, U.S., LLC*, filed in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas is **granted** as conceded.¹ See Trademark Rules 2.127(a) and 2.117(a).

Thus, proceedings are **suspended** pending final disposition of the civil action.

Within twenty days after the final determination of the civil action, the parties shall so notify the Board so that this proceeding may be called up for appropriate action.² Such notification to the Board should include a copy of any final order or final

judgment which issued in the civil action.

During the suspension period, the parties must notify the Board of any address or email address changes for the parties or their attorneys. In addition, the parties are to promptly inform the Board of any other related cases, even if they become aware of such cases during the suspension period.³ Upon resumption, if appropriate, the Board may consolidate related Board cases.
