I. Proposed Amendment

On September 10, 2020, Applicant filed a proposed amendment to its involved application Serial No. 88358451, with Opposer's consent.

By the proposed amendment, Applicant seeks to amend the recitation of the services in International Class 42 of the subject application as follows:¹

From: Design, development, installation and maintenance of computer software

To: Design, development, installation and maintenance of computer software, **excluding software for use in medical devices, in manual and computer-assisted therapeutic and diagnostic medical interventions, and in support of such devices and interventions.**

¹ The language shown in bold are to be added.

The amendment is limiting in nature, as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a). Because Opposer consents thereto, the amendment is **APPROVED** and entered. *See* Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If the amendment resolves this proceeding, Opposer is allowed until **thirty days from the date of this order** to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. *See* Trademark Rule 2.106(c).

If no response is filed, proceedings will be resumed and dates reset, as appropriate

II. Bar Membership Information

It appears that Opposer is represented by an attorney. Effective August 3, 2019, the USPTO amended its rules to require all practitioners qualified under § 11.14(a) to be an active member in good standing and to provide the name of a state in which he or she is an active member in good standing; the date of admission to the bar of the named state; and the bar license number, if one is issued by the named state. 37 C.F.R. § 2.17(b)(3).

Accordingly, Opposer is allowed **thirty days from the mailing date of this order** to provide the information above using the Change of Address form in ESTTA. The bar information entered on the ESTTA Change of Address form will be masked from TTABVUE.

If Opposer fails to comply with this order, the Board may issue an order to show cause.

Proceedings are otherwise **SUSPENDED**.
