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**NOTICE OF CONSOLIDATED OPPOSITION**

Opposer, Molly's Cupcakes IP Holding Company, LLC ("**Opposer**"), a Delaware limited liability company, with the address of 2125 W. Armitage, 3W, Chicago, Illinois 60647, believes that it will be damaged by the registration of the marks MOLLY BZ and MOLLY BZ INFUZED GOURMET FOODZ (& Design), which are the subject of U.S. Trademark Application Serial Nos. 88/651117 and 88/651095 (collectively, the "**Applicant's Marks**"), filed in the name of Molly B'z Inc. ("**Applicant**"), each for "Cookies" in International Class 30, and hereby opposes such registration pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1063. Moreover, because both subject applications are owned by the same Applicant and involve common questions of law and fact, Opposer respectfully submits that consolidation of these oppositions into a single proceeding is appropriate in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 42(a) and TBMP §305.01.

The grounds for opposition are as follows:

1. Opposer, a Delaware limited liability company, owns a portfolio of federal registrations in International Classes 30 and 35 for the trademark MOLLY'S CUPCAKES, in

standard characters as well as in its characteristic logo design (collectively, the “**Molly’s Cupcakes Marks**”), in connection with cupcakes and other bakery desserts, operation of retail bakery shops and provision of take-out bakery services, and online retail and mail order services for bakery desserts. These registrations include:

2. These registrations are valid and subsisting, and Registration Nos. 3,471,100, 3,650,895, and 4,638,014 are now incontestable. Together, these registrations protect Opposer’s

numerous baked goods and related retail bakery shops, take-out bakery services, and mail order services. Copies of these registrations from the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (“PTO”) Database are attached hereto, collectively marked as **Exhibit A**. Certified copies of these properties will be made of record during Opposer’s testimony period.

3. Long prior to the filing date of the applications opposed herein, Opposer obtained the above-identified registrations for the Molly’s Cupcakes Marks for the goods and services identified in such registrations.

4. According to the records of the Delaware Secretary of State attached as **Exhibit B** (accessed August 14, 2020), Applicant was formed as a corporation on May 24, 2019.

5. On October 11, 2019, Applicant filed to register MOLLY BZ and MOLLY BZ INFUZED GOURMET FOODZ (& Design), each for “Cookies” in Class 30 under 15 U.S.C. § 1051(a), listing a first use date of May 23, 2019 in both applications. Copies of these applications from the PTO’s database are attached, collectively marked as **Exhibit C**.

**COUNT I**  
**APPLICATIONS NOT FILED BY OWNER OF MARKS**

6. Opposer repeats, realleges and incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraph 1 through 5 above, as paragraph 6 of this cause of action, as if fully set forth herein.

7. 15 U.S.C. §1051(a)(3)(A) permits the “owner of a trademark used in commerce” to request registration and requires that use-based applications include a statement that “the person making the verification believes that he or she, or the juristic person in whose behalf he or she makes the verification, to be the owner of the mark sought to be registered.”

8. The subject applications were filed listing “Molly B'z Inc.” as the owner.

9. The records of the Delaware Secretary of State (*see* **Exhibit B**) indicate that Applicant was formed as a corporation on May 24, 2019, a day after its claimed May 23, 2019 date of first use.

10. On information and belief, Molly B'z Inc. is therefore not “the owner of [the opposed] trademark[s] used in commerce.” *See* 15 U.S.C. §1051(a)(3)(A). That is, if Applicant was not yet formed, *i.e.*, not yet in existence, until after the at least as early as May 23, 2019 first use date listed in the applications, Applicant’s Marks were being used by another person or entity not properly identified in the applications as the owner.

11. The subject applications are therefore void *ab initio*, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. §§ 1051(a)(1), (a)(3)(A), because, on information and belief, the wrong entity was named as the owner in the applications.

**COUNT II**  
**DEFICIENT VERIFIED STATEMENTS**

12. Opposer repeats, realleges and incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraph 1 through 5 above, as paragraph 12 of this cause of action, as if fully set forth herein.

13. 37 C.F.R. §2.33 requires that every application under Section 1(a) include a verified statement that “the facts set forth in the application are true.” Moreover, under 37 C.F.R. § 2.34, an applicant must include “The date of the applicant's first use of the mark anywhere on or in connection with the goods or services” and “The date of the applicant's first use of the mark in commerce.”

14. Applicant listed May 23, 2019 as the date of first use anywhere and in commerce of Applicant’s Marks in the subject applications. *See* **Exhibit C**.

15. Applicant’s May 24, 2019 corporate formation, as reflected in the records of the Delaware Secretary of State’s Office (*see* **Exhibit B**), contradicts the May 23, 2019 date of first

use recited in Application Nos. 88/651117 and 88/651095, being a day *later than* the claimed date of first use for Applicant's Marks. If Applicant was not formed; hence, not in existence, until May 24, 2019, it necessarily follows that it could not have begun using Applicant's Marks as of the May 23<sup>rd</sup> first use date listed in the subject applications. These inconsistencies contradict the facts included in the verified statements filed with Applicant's Marks.

16. The Applicant's Marks should be denied registration as both being void *ab initio* because Applicant was not yet in existence to be providing the goods as of the listed first use date. Such errors in the verified statements constitute an independent basis for refusing registration of Applicant's Marks.

**COUNT III**  
**FAILURE TO DISCLAIM UNREGISTRABLE MATTER**

17. Opposer repeats, realleges and incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraph 1 through 5 above, as paragraph 17 of this cause of action, as if fully set forth herein.

18. Opposer opposes registration of Applicant's Marks on the separate and independent ground that registration should be denied for failure to disclaim what, on information and belief, is unregistrable matter.

19. The consents filed with Application Nos. 88/651117 and 88/651095 (copies from PTO database attached as part of **Exhibit C**) recite that "**Molly B**" is the nickname of Ms. Molly Blakeley. However, Applicant's Marks include the separate element "**BZ**" without any identification of what this precise two-letter element stands for or otherwise means.

20. Attached as **Exhibit D** is a printout from <https://acronymfinder.com> (accessed on August 14, 2020) for "BZ," listing, among other possible definitions, "Business", "Busy", and "Belize."



21. On information and belief, if the “BZ” element in Applicant’s Marks is an acronym for “Business” then it must be disclaimed as descriptive.

22. On information and belief, if the “BZ” element in Applicant’s Marks is an acronym for “Busy” then it must be disclaimed as descriptive.

23. On information and belief, if the “BZ” element in Applicant’s Marks is an acronym for “Belize” then it must be disclaimed as geographically descriptive and/or geographically deceptively misdescriptive.

**COUNT IV**  
**LIKELIHOOD OF CONFUSION**

24. Opposer repeats, realleges and incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraph 1 through 5 above, as paragraph 24 of this cause of action, as if fully set forth herein.

25. Opposer has priority over Applicant for a mark containing the term “Molly” in connection with baked goods, desserts, and related products in Class 30.

26. Applicant’s Marks so closely resemble Opposer’s Molly’s Cupcakes Marks in appearance, sound, and overall commercial impression that, if registered, they are likely to cause confusion, mistake or deception on the Register as to any affiliation, association or sponsorship between Opposer and Applicant, in violation of 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

27. Foremost, Applicant’s Marks are confusingly similar to the Molly’s Cupcakes Marks under the *DuPont* test. Applicant’s Marks and the Molly’s Cupcakes Marks share the identical word “Molly” as the dominant component, positioned as the introductory term in all of these source identifiers. Applicant’s MOLLY BZ word mark and the Molly’s Cupcakes Marks likewise both constitute short, two-word phrases. The “BZ” element in Applicant’s Marks appears to be descriptive (as explained in Count III above), and therefore fails to meaningfully distinguish MOLLY BZ and MOLLY BZ INFUZED GOURMET FOODZ (& Design) from

MOLLY’S CUPCAKES. Moreover, the difference in appearance from Applicant’s inclusion of the design element in Application No. 88/651095 is likewise insufficient to preclude likely confusion. Where a trademark consists of a word and design portion, the word portion is more likely to be impressed on the public’s memory.

28. The Molly’s Cupcakes Marks and Applicant’s Marks are also confusingly similar phonetically. These source identifiers are in fact acoustically identical in regard to the dominant “Molly” components.

29. Applicant has applied to register its marks with cookies—items identical and otherwise directly related to the baked desserts and other baked goods in Class 30, as well as to the retail bakery shops, take-out bakery services, and mail order services in Class 35, for which Opposer has registered and is using its Molly’s Cupcakes Marks, thereby heightening the likelihood of confusion on the Register.

30. Applicant’s Mark so closely resembles the Molly’s Cupcakes Marks that its registration is likely to cause confusion, mistake or deception on the Register, within the meaning of Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act.

31. Applicant’s registration of marks nearly identical to Opposer’s Molly’s Cupcakes Marks will damage Opposer’s rights by taking away from the distinctiveness of Opposer’s Molly’s Cupcakes Marks on the Principal Register, thereby narrowing Opposer’s scope of protection for such marks on the Principal Register.

32. Opposer has not authorized or consented to Applicant’s registration of Applicant’s Marks in the United States.

33. If Applicant were to be granted registrations for the marks herein opposed, it would obtain thereby at least a prima facie exclusive right to these marks for Applicant’s goods

in International Class 30 on the Principal Register. Such registrations would be a source of damage and injury to Opposer, as set forth herein.

WHEREFORE, Opposer respectfully requests that this opposition be sustained and that registration of the marks MOLLY BZ and MOLLY BZ INFUZED GOURMET FOODZ (& Design), Application Serial Nos. 88/651117 and 88/651095 for the Class 30 products specified therein, be refused and that no registrations should issue thereon to Applicant.
