

CONSOLIDATED NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Opposer BeneSol Inc. (“BeneSol”), through its attorneys Perkins Coie LLP, hereby files this Consolidated Notice of Opposition against Healthe, Inc.’s (“Applicant”) U.S. Application Serial Nos. 90/141,873, 90/141,756, 90/141,925, 90/141,948, 90/141,678, 90/141,916, 90/141,842, 90/141,939, 90/141,609, and 90/141,907, published in the Official Gazette on February 2, 2021, and U.S. Application Serial Nos. 90/141,956 and 90/141,863, published in the Official Gazette on April 13, 2021, for the HEALTHE and Design Marks, shown above (“Applicant’s Marks”), in Classes 9 and 11, because BeneSol will be damaged by the registration

of Applicant's Marks in those classes. BeneSol hereby opposes registration of Applicant's Marks in Classes 9 and 11 on the basis of a likelihood of confusion under Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act, 15, U.S.C. § 1052(d).

On March 4, 2021, BeneSol filed and was granted a 30-Day Extension of Time to oppose U.S. Application Serial Nos. 90/141,873, 90/141,756, 90/141,925, 90/141,948, 90/141,678, 90/141,916, 90/141,842, 90/141,939, 90/141,609, and 90/141,907 until April 3, 2021. Subsequently, on April 5, 2021, BeneSol filed and was granted an additional 60-Day Extension of Time to oppose those same applications until June 2, 2021.

As grounds for this Opposition, BeneSol alleges as follows:

I. PARTIES

1. BeneSol, Inc. is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Washington, having its principal office at 100 Ravine Lane NE, Suite 310, Bainbridge Island, Washington 98110.

2. Upon information and belief, Applicant is a corporation organized under the law of the State of Delaware, having its principal office at 3905 W. Eau Gallie Blvd., Suite 101, Melbourne, Florida 32934.


II. BENESOL'S MARKS AND REGISTRATIONS AND RIGHTS THEREIN

3. BeneSol is in the business of developing new and ground-breaking ultraviolet light therapy devices to improve health and wellness, including to treat vitamin D deficiencies and certain skin disorders. Since at least as early as 2018, BeneSol has adopted and used, in commerce, a unique "sun" design featuring overlapping yellow circles in connection with its phototherapy devices (the "SUN DESIGN Common Law Mark"), as well as the same "sun" design in

combination with BeneSol’s “Solius” brand name (the “SOLIUS & Design Common Law Mark”), examples of which are shown below:



4. BeneSol also owns a trademark registration for its SOLIUS “sun” logo design on the Principal Register of the United States Patent and Trademark Office (“USPTO”), for the goods set forth in the chart below (the “SOLIUS & Design Registration”). A true and correct copy of the registration certificate for BeneSol’s SOLIUS & Design Registration, as well as the electronic database records of the USPTO showing the current status and title of the registration, are attached hereto as Exhibit A. The SOLIUS & Design Registration, SUN DESIGN Common Law Mark, and SOLIUS & Design Common Law Mark are collectively referred to herein as the “SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark.”

5. BeneSol’s goods covered under the SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark shall be referred to as the “SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods.”

6. The federal registration for the SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark is valid and subsisting and constitutes *prima facie* evidence of the validity of BeneSol’s registration and of BeneSol’s

ownership of and exclusive rights to use BeneSol's registered SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark in connection with the SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods as covered under the respective registration.

7. The SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark has achieved consumer recognition in association with the SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods due to BeneSol's use of the SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark in connection with the SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods.

8. The SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark is distinctive of the SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods, generating valuable goodwill that is associated with BeneSol. BeneSol generated such goodwill before Applicant's filing date for Applicant's Marks on August 27, 2020, and, upon information and belief, any other priority date upon which Applicant may rely.

9. At no time has BeneSol granted permission, written or otherwise, to Applicant to use or register any form of Applicant's Marks.

III. APPLICANT'S MARKS AND APPLICATIONS

10. BeneSol realleges and incorporates by reference the preceding allegations of this Notice of Opposition.

11. On August 27, 2020, Applicant filed Application Serial No. 90/141,873 under Section 1(b), based on its *bona fide* intent to use the mark in commerce, seeking registration of the



healthe mark, which resulted in the publication of Application Serial No. 90/141,873 on February 2, 2021, in connection with the following goods in Class 9: “electronic regulating and control devices for the operation of lighting sources; motion sensors; light illumination sensors; electric switches featuring wireless control; electrical switches; lighting controls; lighting control apparatus.”

12. On August 27, 2020, Applicant filed Application Serial No. 90/141,956 under Section 1(b), based on its *bona fide* intent to use the mark in commerce, seeking registration of the



healthē mark, which resulted in the publication of Application Serial No. 90/141,956 on April 13, 2021, in connection with the following goods in Class 11: “light bulbs; LED light bulbs; lighting fixtures; lighting installations; electric lamps; lamps; disinfecting ultraviolet lamps housed in a container or cover for disinfecting objects placed therein; sanitizing apparatus using ultraviolet light for sanitizing air and surfaces of objects, not for medical purposes; ultraviolet ray lamps, not for medical purposes; circadian rhythms adjustment lamps, not for medical purposes.”

13. On August 27, 2020, Applicant filed Application Serial No. 90/141,756 under Section 1(b), based on its *bona fide* intent to use the mark in commerce, seeking registration of the

14. On August 27, 2020, Applicant filed Application Serial No. 90/141,925 under Section 1(b), based on its *bona fide* intent to use the mark in commerce, seeking registration of the



healthē mark, which resulted in the publication of Application Serial No. 90/141,925 on February 2, 2021, in connection with the following goods in Class 11: “light bulbs; LED light

bulbs; lighting fixtures; lighting installations; electric lamps; lamps; disinfecting ultraviolet lamps housed in a container or cover for disinfecting objects placed therein; sanitizing apparatus using ultraviolet light for sanitizing air and surfaces of objects, not for medical purposes; ultraviolet ray lamps, not for medical purposes; circadian rhythms adjustment lamps, not for medical purposes.”

16. On August 27, 2020, Applicant filed Application Serial No. 90/141,948 under Section 1(b), based on its *bona fide* intent to use the mark in commerce, seeking registration of the

22. On August 27, 2020, Applicant filed Application Serial No. 90/141,907 under Section 1(b), based on its *bona fide* intent to use the mark in commerce, seeking registration of the



mark, which resulted in the publication of Application Serial No. 90/141,907 on February 2, 2021, in connection with the following goods in Class 11: “light bulbs; LED light bulbs; lighting fixtures; lighting installations; electric lamps; lamps; disinfecting ultraviolet lamps

housed in a container or cover for disinfecting objects placed therein; sanitizing apparatus using ultraviolet light for sanitizing air and surfaces of objects, not for medical purposes; ultraviolet ray lamps, not for medical purposes; circadian rhythms adjustment lamps, not for medical purposes.”

23. The goods set forth in U.S. Application Serial Nos. 90/141,873, 90/141,956, 90/141,756, 90/141,925, 90/141,863, 90/141,948, 90/141,678, 90/141,916, 90/141,842, 90/141,939, 90/141,609, and 90/141,907 shall collectively be referred to herein as “Applicant’s Goods.”

24. Upon information and belief, Applicant has not alleged a date of first use or a date of first use in commerce for Applicant’s Marks in connection with Applicant’s Goods.

IV. PRIORITY

25. As set forth herein, BeneSol owns prior rights in the SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark.

26. BeneSol’s filing date for the SOLIUS & Design Registration, as well as BeneSol’s first use of its SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark in connection with the SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods, occurred prior to the filing date of Application Serial Nos. 90/141,873, 90/141,956, 90/141,756, 90/141,925, 90/141,863, 90/141,948, 90/141,678, 90/141,916, 90/141,842, 90/141,939, 90/141,609, and 90/141,907 on August 27, 2020, and, upon information and belief, any other priority dates upon which Applicant may rely.

27. Therefore, BeneSol’s prior rights in the its SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark predate the filing date of Application Serial Nos. 90/141,873, 90/141,956, 90/141,756, 90/141,925, 90/141,863, 90/141,948, 90/141,678, 90/141,916, 90/141,842, 90/141,939, 90/141,609, and 90/141,907 on August 27, 2020, and, upon information and belief, any other priority dates upon which Applicant may rely.

V. LIKELIHOOD OF CONFUSION

28. BeneSol realleges and incorporates by reference the preceding allegations of this Notice of Opposition.

29. Applicant's Marks wholly incorporate the design portion of the SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark.

30. Applicant's Marks are confusingly similar to the SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark.

31. Applicant's Marks convey an overall commercial impression that is highly similar to that conveyed by the SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark.

32. Applicant's Goods are identical to, overlap with, or are highly related to the SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods.

33. Applicant's Goods are competitive with the SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods.

34. On information and belief, Applicant's Goods and the SOLIUS & Sun Design Goods will be offered in the same or similar trade channels and will have the same or similar potential customers.

35. Applicant's Marks, when used in connection with Applicant's Goods, are likely to cause confusion, mistake, or deception that Applicant's Goods are those of BeneSol, or that Applicant's Goods are otherwise endorsed, sponsored, or approved by BeneSol, or are likely to cause confusion, mistake, or deception as to the affiliation, connection, or association between Applicant and BeneSol.

36. Registration of Applicant's Marks will damage BeneSol because such registration would grant statutory, exclusive rights to Applicant in violation of BeneSol's prior and superior rights, and would unduly narrow the scope of protection afforded to the SOLIUS & Sun Design Mark.

37. Accordingly, Applicant's Application Serial Nos. 90/141,873, 90/141,956, 90/141,756, 90/141,925, 90/141,863, 90/141,948, 90/141,678, 90/141,916, 90/141,842, 90/141,939, 90/141,609, and 90/141,907 to register Applicant's Marks should be refused registration under Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

Request for Relief

WHEREFORE, BeneSol believes that it will be damaged by registration of Applicant's Marks in Classes 9 and 11 as set forth in Application Serial Nos. 90/141,873, 90/141,956, 90/141,756, 90/141,925, 90/141,863, 90/141,948, 90/141,678, 90/141,916, 90/141,842, 90/141,939, 90/141,609, and 90/141,907, BeneSol respectfully requests that this opposition be sustained and that registration of Applicant's Marks in Classes 9 and 11 be refused. The filing fee in the amount of \$7,200 is being transmitted electronically with this submission.

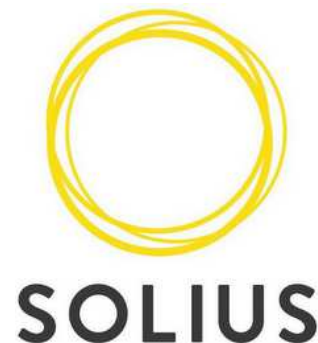
