**MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE**

Applicant, Sports Logos International, LLC (“Applicant”), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby requests that the Board consolidate Opposition Nos. 91269724, 91269728, 91269730, 91269722, 91269723, 91269725, 91269726, 91269727, 91269731, 91269867, 91269866, 91269865, 91269863, 91269862, 91269876, 91269875, 91269874, 91269873, 91269872, 91269871, 91269869, 91269868, 91269883, 91269882, 91269881, 91269880, 91269879, 91269878, 91269877, and 91269884 (collectively, the “Opposition Proceedings”). “When cases involving common questions of law or fact are pending before the Board, the Board may order the consolidation of the cases.” TBMP § 511; *see* FED. TBMP § 511. The Board will also consider the identity of the parties. *Id.*

Applicant submits that the Opposition Proceedings involve identical parties and common questions of law and fact. In particular, the Opposition Proceedings involve oppositions to the registration of Applicant’s marks by Gravy Keg, LLC (“Opposer”) on the basis of priority and

likelihood of confusion. Applicant alleges in the Opposition Proceedings that Opposer has not used the Subject Marks in commerce. Accordingly, the Opposition Proceedings involve common questions of law and fact. Moreover, the savings in time, effort, and expense which will be gained by consolidating 30 separate oppositions involving common questions of law and fact outweigh any prejudice or inconvenience that may be caused thereby. Accordingly, Applicant respectfully requests that the Board consolidate the Opposition Proceedings.
