Opposer, SEE, Inc., a Michigan corporation, having a principal place of business at 19800 W. Eight Mile Road, Southfield, Michigan 48075 (“Opposer”), believes that it is and will continue to be damaged by registration of the mark ISEE in the name of Liang Jingyu (“Applicant”) shown in U.S. Trademark Application Serial No. 87160564, and hereby opposes the same.

As grounds of opposition, Opposer alleges that:

1. SEE, Inc. began producing its eyewear, and related goods and services, under the mark SEE in 1998. SEE, Inc. sells its SEE products throughout the world, both through its website and through its brick and mortar stores.

2. SEE, Inc. is the owner of and uses the trademarks SEE, SEE EYEWEAR, SEE SELECTIVE EYEWEAR ELEMENTS, and SEE CORE COLLECTION (the “SEE Marks”), among others, in connection with eyewear and related goods and services in the United States and throughout the world.

3. As a result of this use, SEE, Inc. has obtained several SEE and SEE-formative trademark registrations, including in the US as set forth in the table below (collectively, the “SEE Marks”):

6. There is no issue as to priority. SEE, Inc. used, filed, and/or registered the SEE Marks in connection with its goods and services long prior to Applicant’s September 3, 2016 filing date.

7. Upon information and belief, Applicant did not use its ISEE mark prior to SEE, Inc.’s first use of the SEE Marks.

8. Applicant’s ISEE mark is virtually identical to Opposer’s SEE Marks.

9. Applicant’s ISEE mark is a close approximation of SEE, Inc.’s Mark.

10. Applicant's Goods are identical and/or closely related to the goods and services advertised, promoted, offered, and/or sold by SEE, Inc. in connection with SEE, Inc.'s Mark.

11. Because the purchasing public has come to recognize and associate the goods and services of SEE, Inc. by the SEE Marks, Applicant's proposed ISEE mark is likely to be confused with or suggest a connection to SEE, Inc.

12. Opposer is not connected with the goods sold by Applicant under its ISEE mark.

13. The fame and reputation of SEE, Inc. is such that, if Applicant's ISEE mark is used with Applicant's designated goods, a connection with SEE, Inc. will be presumed.

14. Applicant's ISEE mark in Application No. 87160564 so resembles SEE, Inc.'s SEE Marks and the goods identified are so closely related to the goods and services of SEE, Inc. as to be likely, when used in connection with Applicant's goods, to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive in violation of Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act, 15 USC §1052(d).

15. If Applicant were granted the registration herein opposed, it would obtain at least a *prima facie* exclusive right to use of the ISEE mark in connection with the designated goods. Such registration would be a source of injury and damage to SEE, Inc.'s prior and established rights in the SEE Marks.

WHEREFORE, Opposer respectfully requests that registration of the ISEE mark, Application Serial No. 87160564, be refused and that this opposition be sustained.
