NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Opposer Mothercare Global Brand Limited (“Opposer” or “Mothercare”) believes it will be damaged by registration of the mark shown in Ser. No. 90/710,475 (the “Application”) for the goods recited in Class 20. Opposer brings this opposition against the Application under 15 U.S.C. § 1063. Opposer asserts the following as its grounds for opposition: (1) priority and likelihood of confusion under 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d) based on Opposer’s registered rights, and (2) no bona fide use of the applied-for mark by the Applicant with some or all of the identified goods in United States commerce prior to the filing of the use-based Application under 15 U.S.C. § 1051(a).

THE PARTIES

1. Opposer Mothercare is a private limited company organized under the laws of the United Kingdom with an address of Cherry Tree Road, Watford, United Kingdom WD24 6SH.

2. According to USPTO records, Applicant Shenzhen Tuteng Technology Co., Ltd. is a Chinese limited company (Ltd.) with an address of 19A05, Harbin Bldg, 7045 Beihuan Avenue, Lianhua Street, Futian District, Shenzhen, Guangdong, China 518035.

FACTS

Mothercare and its MOTHERCARE Mark

3. Mothercare is a leading global provider and retailer of baby care and parenting products, including among other products clothing, toys, nursery essentials, car seats, and strollers, as well as related goods and services.

4. Since at least as early as 1961, Mothercare has used the MOTHERCARE trademark and other trademarks incorporating MOTHERCARE (collectively, the “MOTHERCARE Marks”) in connection with baby care and parenting products. Mothercare has extensively advertised and promoted the goods and services offered under the MOTHERCARE Marks to consumers through a variety of different means, including on its website at the domain <https://www.mothercareplc.com/>. As a result of such efforts, the MOTHERCARE Marks have become widely recognized and well-known as a designation of the products and services offered by Mothercare.

5. Opposer’s MOTHERCARE Marks are inherently distinctive, serving to identify and indicate the source of Mothercare’s goods and services to the consuming public, and to distinguish Mothercare’s goods and services from those of others.

6. Additionally, as a result of Mothercare’s long use and promotion of its MOTHERCARE Marks, the marks have become distinctive and are recognized by

consumers. Opposer has invested significant effort and resources in advertising and promoting its MOTHERCARE Marks and the products and services sold under those marks, with the result that the purchasing public has come to know, rely on, and recognize the products and services of Mothercare by those marks.

7. Mothercare owns trademark registrations throughout the world for its MOTHERCARE Marks, including U.S. Reg. No. 1806981 (the “Mothercare Registration”) for the mark MOTHERCARE that issued on November 30, 1993 and currently covers the following goods and services:

- Class 3 - body cream.
- Class 5 - nursing pads, breast creams, sterilizing preparations and medicated sanitizing powder for personal use.
- Class 6 - safety catches made of metal for cupboards, shock-stops for outlets, door-stops, safety devices; namely, locks for toilet seats.
- Class 8 - spoons, knives, forks, cutlery sets, nail scissors, nail clippers, scissors.
- Class 9 - thermometers, baby alarms, socket covers.
- Class 10 - baby feeding bottles, feeding bottle teats, soothers, medicine spoons, medicine droppers, teethers, ear syringes, inhalers, and nursing pads.
- Class 16 - books on prenatal care and child care; photographic albums.
- Class 18 - purses, safety harnesses.
- Class 20 - photo frames, coat hangers, pillows, safety catches for cupboards (not made of metal).

- Class 21 - bottle brushes, cups and dishes not of precious metal, beakers for kitchen use, bowls, mugs, baby hair brushes and bottle dishwashing brushes, combs, plates.
- Class 24 - pram quilts, mattress covers, sheets, towels, face cloths.
- Class 25 - maternity wear; namely, dresses, suits, T-shirts, jumpers, trousers, blouses, skirts, jackets, dungarees, jeans, socks, cardigans, leggings, tights, night dresses, negligees, night shirts, bras, briefs, slips, panty girdles, camisole tops, french knickers, body shapers, swimsuits, jumpsuits, pinafores; children's wear; namely, swimsuits, jeans, dresses, playsuits, sweatshirts, jogging pants, T-shirts, cardigans, hats, trousers, caps, shoes, shirts, anoraks, socks, dungarees, jackets, skirts, shorts, tights, vests, briefs, body suits, braces, play overalls, waterproof pants, pyjamas, gowns, booties, mittens, pramsuits, bonnets, pants, scarfs, jumpers, blouses, berets, coats, baby wear of stretchable material, rompers, jumpsuits, night dresses, night shirts, slips, slippers, sandals, visors, leotards, bikinis, bibs, shawls, bathrobes, sleepsuits.
- Class 28 - toys for babies, toddlers and young children; namely, soft toys, puzzles, rattles, and mobiles.
- Class 42 - retail and mail order services in the field of wearing apparel for expectant mothers, infants and young children, and supplies for expectant mothers, infants and young children.

The Mothercare Registration is valid and subsisting, and is incontestable pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1065. A copy of the Mothercare Registration and its respective TSDR record is attached as **Exhibit A**.

8. The Mothercare Registration covers goods closely related to the goods in the opposed Application.

The Opposed Application

9. Applicant filed Serial No. 90/710,475 on May 13, 2021 pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1051(a) for the mark MUMCARE (the “Applicant’s Mark”) covering the Class 20 goods “Cradles; Cushions; Beach chairs; Chaise longues; Children's mats used for sleeping; Cots for babies; Curtain holders, not of textile material; Decorative 3D pillows and cushions; Dog beds; Felt pads for furniture legs; Foot rests; Furniture primarily of metal, namely, mirrors, bed frames, dining tables, coffee tables, end tables, desks, display cases, shelving, dog gates, and baby gates; Furniture for children; Head positioning pillows for babies; Head support cushions for babies; Infant walkers; Inflatable chairs; Inflatable mattresses for use when camping; Outdoor furniture; Playpens for babies.” The Application claims a date of first use of Applicant’s Mark with the recited goods of January 31, 2021.

10. On June 24, 2022, the Applicant amended the goods description of the Application to only cover the Class 20 goods “Chaise longues; Cradles; Dog beds; Foot rests; Inflatable chairs; Beach chairs.”

11. Mothercare has priority based on its prior registration of the MOTHERCARE mark in the United States before any priority date in the Applicant's Mark that can be claimed by the Applicant.

**GROUND FOR OPPOSITION—LIKELIHOOD OF CONFUSION
(15 U.S.C. § 1052(D))**

12. Mothercare repeats the allegations above as if set forth fully here.

13. Mothercare has priority in its MOTHERCARE Marks over any priority date in the Applicant's Mark that can be claimed by the Applicant.

14. The Applicant's Mark is confusingly similar to Opposer's MOTHERCARE Marks.

15. The goods recited in the Application are closely related to the goods and services for which Mothercare has registered its MOTHERCARE mark.

16. Upon information and belief, the Applicant's goods will travel in the same or similar channels of trade as Mothercare's goods and services and will be purchased by the same or similar types of consumers who purchase and use Mothercare's goods and services.

17. Mothercare has not given Applicant permission to use or register the mark MUMCARE or any other marks confusingly similar to Opposer's MOTHERCARE Marks.

18. The Applicant's Mark so resembles the MOTHERCARE Marks as to be likely, when used on or in connection with the goods identified in the Application, to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive. Applicant's goods are closely related to the goods and services set forth in the Mothercare Registration. Purchasers and

prospective purchasers are likely to believe that the goods offered under Applicant's Mark are sponsored, endorsed, or approved by Mothercare, or are in some way affiliated, connected, or associated with Mothercare or its products and services.

19. The Application should thus be refused registration under 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

**GROUND FOR OPPOSITION—NO BONA FIDE USE OF THE MARK IN COMMERCE
(15 U.S.C. § 1051(A))**

20. Mothercare repeats the allegations above as if set forth fully here.

21. On information and belief, Applicant was not using MUMCARE in United States commerce with all or some of the goods identified in the Application as of the May 13, 2021 filing date of the Application. Because there was no bona fide use of the Applicant's Mark by Applicant on or in connection with the goods identified in the Application in United States commerce at the time Applicant filed its use-based application, such non-use renders the Application *void ab initio* for failure to comply with the requirements of Section 1(a) of the Trademark Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1051(a).

STANDING & DAMAGE TO OPPOSER

22. Allowing the Application to proceed would damage Opposer because, as explained, consumers are likely to confuse Applicant's goods offered under the MUMCARE mark with Opposer and its MOTHERCARE Marks.

23. Also, allowing the Application to proceed would damage Opposer because registration would give Applicant statutory presumptions and legal rights to which it is not entitled. Those statutory presumptions and legal rights would weaken Opposer's prior registered rights in its MOTHERCARE Marks.

CONCLUSION

24. The Board should sustain the opposition and refuse registration of the Application, Ser. No. 90/710,475.
