The filing of the motion to compel disclosure or discovery shall not toll the time for a party to comply with any initial disclosure requirement, or to respond to any outstanding discovery requests or to appear for any noticed discovery deposition. If the motion to compel was filed after

the close of discovery, the parties need not make pretrial disclosures until directed to do so by the Board. *See* Trademark Rule 2.120(f)(2); TBMP § 523.01.
