NOTICE OF OPPOSITION



Cozy Comfort Company LLC (“Opposer”) believes it will be damaged by the registration of U.S. Trademark Application Serial No. 97/536,349 (the “Application”) for the mark COMFY FEET SLEEPING BAG (“Applicant’s Mark”) and hereby opposes the same. Opposer hereby alleges:

The Parties

1. Opposer is an Arizona limited liability company doing business at 27316 N 64th Dr, Phoenix, Arizona 85083.
2. Upon information and belief, Affordable Handyman of Austin LLC (“Applicant”) is a Texas limited liability company having its principal place of business at 369 Lower Red Rock Road, Bastrop, Texas 78602.

Factual Overview


3. Opposer herein incorporates by reference each of the foregoing paragraphs.
4. Opposer is the owner of the following valid and subsisting U.S. federal trademark registrations for its THE COMFY-formative marks:

5. Opposer also owns valid, subsisting, and continuing common law rights in the trademarks in the following:

Opposer’s Registered Trademarks and Opposer’s Common Law Trademarks are collectively referred to as “Opposer’s Trademarks.” Opposer’s Registered Goods and Opposer’s Common Law Goods are collectively referred to as “Opposer’s Goods.” Opposer’s Registered Services and Opposer’s Common Law Services are collectively referred to as “Opposer’s Services.”

6. THECOMFY.COM receives customers, and potential customers use THECOMFY.COM as a first choice for identifying Opposer and Opposer’s products and services and their source on the Internet. Since at least as early as December 3, 2017, Opposer has continuously used the trademark THECOMFY.COM in interstate commerce in connection with Opposer’s Goods and Opposer’s Services. Examples of such use are attached as Exhibit B.
7. Since at least as early as January 2018, Opposer has continuously used the trademark THECOMFY in interstate commerce in connection with Opposer’s Goods and Opposer’s Services. Examples of such use are attached as Exhibit B.
8. Opposer sells Opposer’s Goods directly to consumers as well as to wholesale entities for sales through brick-and-mortar and on-line retail establishments.
9. Opposer’s Goods are original, unique, and of high quality. Opposer spends great time, care, and cost in designing products, selecting materials, and controlling production, so as to ensure that

- each of Opposer's Goods is of a consistent quality level and is representative of the known quality standard with which customers associate goods sold in connection with Opposer's Trademarks.
10. On December 3, 2017, the holiday episode of ABC's *Shark Tank* reality investment competition television show featured Opposer and Opposer's Goods. Opposer received backing from one of the "sharks." Since that time, Opposer has advertised Opposer's Goods in connection with *Shark Tank*. See Exhibit C. Opposer, Opposer's Goods, Opposer's Services, and Opposer's Trademarks have since received wide media attention.
 11. As a result of its widespread, continuous, and exclusive use of Opposer's Common Law Trademarks to identify Opposer's Common Law Goods and Services and to identify Opposer as the source thereof, Opposer also owns valid, subsisting, and continuing common law rights in Opposer's Common Law Trademarks.
 12. Opposer's Registered Trademarks and Opposer's Common Law Trademarks are distinctive to the consuming marketplace with respect to each mark's respective goods and services.
 13. On August 5, 2022, Applicant filed the Application to register Applicant's Mark in connection with "Sleeping bags" ("Applicant's Goods") in international classification 024. A true and correct copy of the Application is attached hereto as Exhibit D.
 14. Applicant filed the Application under 15 U.S.C. § 1051(b) alleging an intent to use Applicant's Mark in commerce.
 15. The Application continues to be based on 15 U.S.C. § 1051(b) as of the filing date of this Notice of Opposition, according to TSDR records for the Application.
 16. Opposer has not given Applicant any permission or other manner of authorization to use Applicant's Mark or any variation thereof.

COUNT I

Likelihood of Confusion - 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d)

17. Opposer herein incorporates by reference each of the foregoing paragraphs.
18. Opposer has priority with respect to the Application based on the valid and subsisting Opposer's Registrations, which registered before the filing date of the Application.
19. Opposer has priority based on its prior use of Opposer's Registered Trademarks and Opposer's Common Law Trademarks in commerce before the filing date of the Application and any date of first use that Applicant may prove.
20. Applicant's Mark is confusingly similar to each of Opposer's Registered Trademarks in sound, spelling, appearance, connotation, and commercial impression. Applicant's Mark appropriates the term COMFY from each of Opposer's Registered Trademarks.
21. Applicant's Mark is confusingly similar to each of Opposer's Common Law Trademarks in sound, spelling, appearance, connotation, and commercial impression. Applicant's Mark appropriates the term COMFY from each of Opposer's Common Law Trademarks.
22. Applicant's Goods are related to Opposer's Goods and Opposer's Services advertised, promoted, and/or sold by Opposer under both Opposer's Registered Trademarks and Opposer's Common Law Trademarks.
23. Applicant's Mark so resembles Opposer's Registered Trademarks and Opposer's Common Law Trademarks as to be likely, when used in connection with Applicant's Goods, to cause confusion, to cause mistake, or to deceive under 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d). Consumers in the marketplace are likely to mistakenly believe that Applicant's Goods are offered, sponsored, affiliated, approved, or otherwise related to Opposer, Opposer's Goods, or Opposer's Services. Applicant's use or registration of Applicant's Mark will cause Opposer injury because such use or registration is likely to cause confusion, to cause mistake, or to deceive, by incorrectly causing consumers to

believe that the goods offered by Applicant are offered, sponsored, affiliated, approved, or otherwise related to Opposer, Opposer's Goods, or Opposer's Services. Moreover, any defect in goods provided by Applicant under Applicant's Mark may be improperly connected to and injure the reputation and goodwill of Opposer, which Opposer has worked to develop.

24. Opposer asserts that Applicant's Mark is barred from registration because it consists of or comprises a mark which so resembles Opposer's Registered Trademarks and Opposer's Common Law Trademarks as to be likely, when used in connection with Applicant's Goods, to cause confusion, to cause mistake, or to deceive under 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

WHEREFORE, Opposer believes it will be damaged by registration of Applicant's Mark, and so Opposer prays that this Opposition be sustained, that Application Serial No. 97/536,349 be refused registration, and that no registration be issued thereon to Applicant.

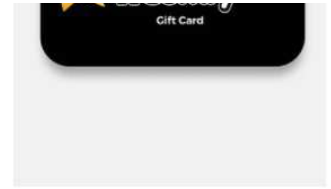
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Ok, we'll be honest: we're still not 100% sure being on The Tank actually happened. But you saw it, right? That was us, wasn't it?

Walking down that famous hallway, having that last set of doors open, and finally stepping into the world of Mark, Lori, Kevin, Barbara, and Robert was the most surreal moment of our lives. This was our chance to stand on the most sacred ground in all of entrepreneurship and pitch five of the most famous names and brilliant minds in business on *our* product. It's like you're suddenly inside your favorite TV show - because we were.





We filmed for about half an hour. (It's then edited down to about an eight-minute segment.) We sang - we laughed - and we stared in amazement as the Sharks tried on their Comfys (even Mark!) and joked around with each other. It's like time was standing still. Amazing.



Were there things we'd do differently? Of course; we think anyone who's ever been lucky enough to stand in The Tank would say the same thing. But our goal was to be entertaining, to be compelling, and to sell the Sharks on what we think could be one of the most successful products in the history of the show. Our business was so young that we still didn't have a product to sell, so we knew we'd have to convince the Sharks to invest in us as much as they would be investing in our idea.




