Petitioner's combined motion, filed December 12, 2005, to amend the petition for cancellation to add a claim of fraud, reset the testimony periods and suspend this proceeding pending the outcome of the motion to amend is granted as uncontested.¹ See Trademark Rule 2.127(a). must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after
completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule
2.125.

request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

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
