The stipulated protective agreement filed on July 14, 2005 is noted. The parties are referred, as appropriate, to TBMP §§ 412.03 (Signature of Protective Order), 412.04 (Filing Confidential Materials With Board), 412.05 (Handling of Confidential Materials by Board).

The parties are advised that only confidential or trade secret information should be filed pursuant to a stipulated protective agreement. Such an agreement may not be used as a means of circumventing paragraphs (d) and (e) of 37 CFR § 2.27, which provide, in essence, that the file of a published application or issued registration, and all

proceedings relating thereto, should otherwise be available for public inspection.

Since it appears not to have been decided, applicant's consented motion to extend discovery, filed August 11, 2005, is granted.

Discovery and trial dates remain as set in the Board's December 20, 2005. order.
