PETITION TO CANCEL

WhataPartnership, L.P., a limited partnership organized under the laws of Delaware, with offices located at 300 Delaware Avenue, Suite 900, Wilmington, DE 19801, hereby petitions the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board to cancel Registration No. 2,480,278 – WHAT-A-RACK (“Respondent’s mark”) for “restaurant services,” registered in the Patent and Trademark Office, Principal Register, on August 21, 2001, by Suite One Staffing Group, Inc. (“Respondent”). In support of this Petition, WhataPartnership, L.P. states that it is and will continue to be damaged by the registration of Respondent’s mark and petitions to cancel the subject registration on the following grounds:

- A. Likelihood of Confusion between Respondent’s mark and Petitioner’s WHATABURGER and family of WHATA marks identified more fully below.
- B. Respondent’s abandonment of use of Respondent’s mark and Respondent’s corresponding Registration No. 2,480,278.

A. LIKELIHOOD OF CONFUSION

1. WhataPartnership, L.P. is the owner of all right, title and interest in and to the trademarks and service marks pleaded in this Petition to Cancel and licenses to Whataburger,

Inc., a Texas corporation with principal offices at 4600 Parkdale Drive, Corpus Christi, Texas 74811-9230, the right to operate and to authorize franchisees to operate restaurants using the pleaded trademarks and service marks. (WhataPartnership, L.P. and Whataburger, Inc. are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Petitioner.")

2. Petitioner, either directly or through its franchisees, operates over 500 restaurants in the United States and Mexico under the WHATABURGER name.

3. Petitioner, through its predecessors in interest, adopted and commenced use of the WHATABURGER name as a service mark for restaurants services in 1950 and has used the name continuously and without interruption to the present day.

4. Petitioner uses the WHATABURGER name not only to identify restaurant services, but also as a trademark to identify a diverse array of food products.

5. Petitioner, prior to Respondent's adoption, use and registration of Respondent's mark, developed a family of WHATA marks to its identify food products as well as collateral goods such as printed materials and clothing.

6. Based on Petitioner's extensive, exclusive and continuous use of its WHATABURGER and WHATA marks in connection with restaurant services, food products and collateral goods, the name WHATABURGER and Petitioner's other WHATA marks have come to be recognized among the consuming public as designators of origin with respect to said services and products.

7. Petitioner is the owner of all right, title and interest in and to the following federal service mark and trademark registrations, which presently are valid and subsisting in law.

Petitioner will submit current status and title copies, prepared by the Patent and Trademark

Office, of its pleaded registrations at the appropriate time in this proceeding. Photocopies are attached hereto as Exhibit A.

- (a) Registration No. 652,137 – **WHATABURGER** for “hamburger sandwich,” registered on the Principal Register September 24, 1957.
- (b) Registration No. 891,082 – **WHATABURGER** for “restaurant services and drive in restaurant services,” registered on the Principal Register May 12, 1970.
- (c) Registration No. 1,011,927 – **WHATABURGER** for “hamburgers, cheeseburgers, french fried potatoes, fried pies, onion rings, malt and shake beverages, and frankfurter sandwiches” and “restaurant and drive-in restaurant services,” registered on the Principal Register on May 27, 1975.
- (d) Registration No. 1,011,928 – **WHATABURGER & W Design** for “hamburgers, cheeseburgers, french fried potatoes, fried pies, onion rings, malt and shake beverages, and frankfurter sandwiches” and “restaurant and drive-in restaurant services,” registered on the Principal Register on May 27, 1975.
- (e) Registration No. 1,014,196 – **WHATABURGER JR.** for “prepared hamburger sandwich for consumption on or off premises,” registered on the Principal Register on June 24, 1975.
- (f) Registration No. 1,116,918 – **WHATAMEAL** for “prepared meal consisting of a hamburger sandwich, french fries and a beverage for consumption on or off the premises,” registered on the Principal Register April 24, 1979.
- (g) Registration No. 1,206,344 – **WHATACATCH** for “breaded fish fillets suitable for fish sandwiches” and “prepared fish sandwich for consumption on or off the premises,” registered on the Principal Register August 24, 1982.
- (h) Registration No. 2,150,703 – **WHATASIZE IT!** for “restaurant services featuring a prepared meal containing french fries and a soft drink for consumption on or off the premises,” registered on the Principal Register April 14, 1998.
- (i) Registration No. 2,160,285 – **WHATACHICK’N** for “chicken sandwich,” registered on the Principal Register May 26, 1998.
- (j) Registration No. 2,335,590 – **WHATABURGER** for “restaurant services,” registered on the Principal Register March 28, 2000.
- (k) Registration No. 2,372,372 – **WHATAKIDS** for “clothing for children, namely, shirts, polo shirts, t-shirts, dresses, overalls, onesies, baseball caps and hats,” registered on the Principal Register August 1, 2000.

- (l) Registration No. 2,409,945 – **WHATACHILL** for “frozen flavored fruit drinks offered for sale exclusively through applicant’s restaurants,” registered on the Principal Register December 5, 2000.
- (m) Registration No. 2,418,380 – **WHATAGUY** for “restaurant services,” registered on the Principal Register January 2, 2000.
- (n) Registration No. 2,432,191 – **WHATAKIDS** for “restaurant services,” registered on the Principal Register February 27, 2001.
- (o) Registration No. 2,519,854 – **WHATACOMIX** for “comic books and children’s activity books,” registered on the Principal Register December 18, 2001.
- (p) Registration No. 2,534,527 – **WHATAPLACE! WHATATASTE!** for “restaurant services,” registered on the Principal Register January 29, 2002.
- (q) Registration No. 2,757,109 – **WHATABURGER** for “charitable fundraising services,” registered on the Principal Register August 26, 2003.
- (r) Registration No. 2,846,139 – **WHATABLENDERS** for “milk shake drinks, bases for milk shake drinks and candy flavored toppings therefor, registered on the Principal Register May 25, 2004.

8. Petitioner’s Reg. Nos. 652,137; 891,082; 1,011,927; 1,011,928; 1,014,196; 1,116,918; 1,206,344; 2,150,703; and 2,160,285 are incontestable as to the products and services listed therein and are conclusive evidence of the validity of the registered marks, Petitioner’s ownership of the marks, and of Petitioner’s exclusive right to use the marks in commerce on or in connection with the products and services identified in the registrations.

9. By reason of Petitioner’s extensive, exclusive and continuous use of its **WHATABURGER** and **WHATA** marks, Petitioner has become known and recognized as the owner of the aforesaid marks.

10. On information and belief, Respondent provides restaurant services under Respondent’s mark.

11. Respondent’s services are identical and/or otherwise closely related to Petitioner’s goods and services offered under Petitioner’s **WHATABURGER** and **WHATA** marks.

12. Respondent's mark so resembles Petitioner's WHATABURGER and WHATA marks as to be likely, when applied to Respondent's services, to cause confusion, mistake and to deceive.

13. Respondent's mark is confusingly similar to Petitioner's WHATABURGER and WHATA marks, so that continued registration of Respondent's mark would be inconsistent with and damaging to Petitioner's prior and exclusive rights in and to its WHATABURGER and WHATA marks in connection with the goods and services with which they are used.

14. Petitioner will continue to be damaged by the registration of Respondent's mark.

B. ABANDONMENT

15. Petitioner realleges and incorporates by reference Paragraphs 1 through 14 of this Petition to Cancel.

16. On information and belief, Respondent has made no commercial use of Respondent's mark in connection with restaurant services for at least three years.

17. On information and belief, Respondent's non-use and/or discontinuance of use of Respondent's mark in connection with restaurant services has been without the intention to resume use of Respondent's mark in connection with the stated services.

18. On information and belief, Respondent has abandoned use of Respondent's mark and Respondent's corresponding Registration No. 2,480,278.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that its Petition be sustained and that Registration No. 2,480,278 be cancelled.


