ANSWER

Submitted with this document is a Certificate of Service on Petitioner’s Attorney of Record. Coenco, Inc. (hereinafter “Registrant”) answers the Petition to Cancel filed in this matter as follows:

1. Registrant lacks sufficient information to admit or deny the allegations contained in Paragraph 1 of the Petition to Cancel and therefore denies those allegations.
2. Registrant lacks sufficient information to admit or deny the allegations contained in Paragraph 2 of the Petition to Cancel and therefore denies those allegations.
3. Registrant lacks sufficient information to admit or deny the allegations contained in Paragraph 3 of the Petition to Cancel and therefore denies those allegations.
4. Registrant admits the allegations contained in Paragraph 4 of the Petition to Cancel, but states further that Petitioner failed to note that U.S. Trademark Registration No.

0674197 was abandoned on May 9, 2000 by Petitioner (a TARR Status Report for U.S. Registration No. 0674197 is included herewith as Exhibit 1). No other applications were filed for the COEN mark by Petitioner for nearly six years until U.S. Trademark Application No. 76/657,739 was filed on April 3, 2006 (a TARR Status Report for U.S. Trademark Application No. 76/657,739 is included herewith as Exhibit 2).

5. Registrant admits the allegations contained in Paragraph 5 of the Petition to Cancel, but states further that U.S. Trademark Application No. 76/657,739 was filed by Petitioner on April 3, 2006, almost six years after U.S. Registration No. 0674197 was abandoned by Petitioner on May 9, 2000.

6. Registrant admits the allegations contained in Paragraph 6 of the Petition to Cancel, but states further that Registrant also owns U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,734,891 for COENCO for “ventilating fans and air circulation systems, comprising a combination of fans, vents, burners, heating units, air conditioning units, temperature sensors and makeup air units, for agricultural, commercial and industrial use,” with a date of first use listed on the registration of July 11, 1983, a filing date of August 21, 2002, and a registration date of July 8, 2003 (a TARR Status Report for U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,734,891 is included herewith as Exhibit 3). Registrant further adds that it also owns U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,257,448 for COENCO’S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM for “ventilating fans and air circulation systems, comprising a combination of fans, vents, burners, heating units, air conditioning units, temperature sensors and makeup air units, for agricultural, commercial and industrial use,” with a date of first use listed on the registration of April 1, 1998, a filing date of March 25, 1996, and a registration date of June 29, 1999 (a Status Report for U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,257,448 is included herewith as Exhibit 4). U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,257,448 was

cited in the registration which is the subject of this cancellation action as a prior registration of Registrant. U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,257,448 is incontestable due to Registrant's filing of a Section 15 affidavit and has enjoyed incontestable status under 15 U.S.C. § 1065 (Section 15 of the Lanham Act) since September 11, 2005. (Hereinafter, the COENCO, COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM, and COENCO REAL AIR MOVER/SILENCER marks are collectively referred to as "the Coenco Marks," and the U.S. trademark registrations listed above for these marks are collectively referred to as "the Coenco Registrations.")

7. Registrant lacks sufficient information to admit or deny the allegations contained in Paragraph 7 of the Petition to Cancel and therefore denies those allegations.

8. Registrant lacks sufficient information to admit or deny the allegations contained in Paragraph 8 of the Petition to Cancel and therefore denies those allegations.

AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES

9. Registrant asserts that Petitioner has had constructive notice of Registrant's use of the COENCO REAL AIR MOVER/SILENCER mark and of the existence of the application which resulted in U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,732,248 for this mark since at least as early as August 21, 2002, the filing date of the application which resulted in that registration. In the over five years that the use of and the existence of the U.S. trademark application and eventual registration for the COENCO REAL AIR MOVER/SILENCER mark by Registrant have been public knowledge, the Petitioner has failed to take any action to enforce its perceived rights.

10. Despite Petitioner's constructive knowledge for at least five years of the Registrant's actual and continuous use of the mark for over five years as shown in U.S.

Registration No. 2,732,248, Petitioner has never demanded that Registrant stop using its mark in commerce or attempted to assert exclusive rights to the name COEN.

11. Registrant asserts that Petitioner has had constructive notice of Registrant's use of the COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM mark and of the existence of the application which resulted in U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,257,448 for this mark since at least as early as March 25, 1996, the filing date of the application which resulted in that registration. In the over twelve years that the use of and the existence of the U.S. trademark application and eventual registration for the COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM mark by Registrant have been public knowledge, Petitioner has failed to take any action to enforce its perceived rights.

12. A portion of the COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM mark is the COENCO portion of the mark, which also exists as a portion of the mark which is the subject of the present cancellation action. Registrant cited the COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM mark in its listing of prior registration numbers in the registration which is the subject of the present Petition to Cancel.

13. U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,257,448 for COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM coexisted on the Principal Register with the Petitioner's abandoned COEN registration prior to the COEN registration's abandonment by Petitioner.

14. Despite Petitioner's constructive knowledge for at least twelve years of the Registrant's actual and continuous use for over 10 years of the mark as shown in U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,257,448 and despite the coexistence on the Principal Register of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office of Registrant's U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,257,448 for COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM and Petitioner's now-abandoned COEN registration,

Petitioner has never demanded that Registrant stop using its mark in commerce or attempted to assert exclusive rights to the name COEN.

15. Registrant asserts that Petitioner has had constructive notice of Registrant's use for over 25 years (a date of first use of at least as early as July 11, 1983) of the COENCO mark and of the existence of the trademark application which resulted in U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,734,891 for this mark since at least as early as August 21, 2002, the filing date of the application which resulted in that registration. In the over 25 years that the COENCO mark has been in use and the over five years that the existence of the U.S. trademark application and eventual registration for the COENCO mark by Registrant and that use have been in the public knowledge, Petitioner has failed to take any action to enforce its perceived rights.

16. The only word COENCO of the COENCO mark exists as a portion of the mark which is the subject of the present cancellation action.

17. Despite Petitioner's constructive knowledge for at least five years of the Registrant's actual and continuous use for over 25 years of the mark as shown in U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,734,891, Petitioner has never demanded that Registrant stop using its mark in commerce or attempted to assert exclusive rights to the name COEN.

18. Registrant asserts that despite Registrant's actual and continuous use of the COENCO mark for over 25 years and despite Petitioner's constructive knowledge of the existence and use of the COENCO marks for over twelve years, Petitioner failed to file an opposition action to the issuance of any of the COENCO registrations, including the registration which is the subject of the current cancellation action, after publication for opposition in the Official Gazette was made for the COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM mark on December 17, 1996 (almost twelve years ago), for the COENCO mark on April 15, 2003 (over five years

ago), and for the COENCO REAL AIR MOVER/SILENCER mark on March 19, 2003 (also over five years ago).

19. Registrant asserts that despite Registrant's actual and continuous use of the COENCO mark for over 25 years and despite Petitioner's constructive knowledge of the existence and use of the COENCO marks for over twelve years, Petitioner failed to file a cancellation action to cancel any of the COENCO registrations for the over nine years that the COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM mark has been registered with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office and for the almost five years that the COENCO and COENCO REAL AIR MOVER/SILENCER mark has been registered, until now. Registrant notes that Registrant has not filed a cancellation action with respect to the COENCO'S POSITIVE AIR SYSTEM registration.

20. Petitioner has taken no action consistent with enforcing its rights to the word COEN. No cease and desist letter was sent by Petitioner to Registrant, and none has been sent to Registrant as of the filing date of this Answer. Upon information and belief, Petitioner has not filed suit against any person or entity related to the use of the COEN word seeking injunctive relief or damages or related to any claim of infringement or dilution.

21. Registrant asserts that Petitioner's lack of diligence in and general failure to enforce its perceived rights in the word COEN until over 25 years of use by Registrant of the COENCO mark and until Petitioner has enjoyed constructive knowledge of Registrant's use of the COENCO marks for over twelve years, thereby allowing Petitioner to build up goodwill in and spend significant funds as well as invest substantial time and effort in advertising and promoting its COENCO marks for over 25 years, is effectively lying in wait to blindside Registrant at the last minute despite Registrant's due diligence in enforcing its rights through the

U.S. Patent and Trademark Office registration process with Registrant's three issued trademark registrations filed and registered over a twelve-year period.

22. Registrant further asserts that Petitioner's U.S. Trademark Registration No. 0674197 for COEN was abandoned by Petitioner over eight years ago, on May 9, 2000. Petitioner failed to file any trademark application for the word COEN or any similar words, upon information and belief, for almost six years from the abandonment date of U.S. Trademark Registration No. 0674197, until U.S. Trademark Application No. 76/657,739 was filed on April 3, 2006. Registrant asserts that Petitioner's failure to secure its perceived rights for almost six years constitutes abandonment of any right to the exclusive use of the COEN mark.

23. Registrant further asserts that to the extent that Petitioner has failed to enforce any claim to exclusive rights in the COEN word and the word COENCO has been used by Registrant for over 25 years, with Petitioner's knowledge for nearly twelve years of Registrant's use and Petitioner's knowledge of Registrant's registration of the COENCO marks for many years, Petitioner has abandoned its right to the exclusive use of the word COEN.

24. Registrant asserts that U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,732,248, the subject registration of the current cancellation action, is incontestable under 15 U.S.C. § 1065 (Section 15 of the Lanham Act) based on the incontestability status of U.S. Registration No. 2,257,448, which registration was cited as a prior registration number in the registration of the current cancellation action and which registration contains the word COENCO which is common to the two registrations and a subject of this dispute.

25. Registrant affirmatively states that Petitioner is barred from asserting this action by reason of laches on the part of Petitioner.

26. Registrant affirmatively states that Petitioner is barred from asserting this action by reason of estoppel on the part of Petitioner.

27. Registrant affirmatively states that Petitioner is barred from asserting this action by reason of unclean hands on the part of Petitioner.

28. Registrant affirmatively states that Petitioner is barred from asserting this action by reason of acquiescence on the part of Petitioner.

29. Registrant affirmatively states that Petitioner is barred from asserting this action by reason of license on the part of Petitioner.

30. Registrant affirmatively states that Petitioner is barred from asserting this action by reason of abandonment on the part of Petitioner.

31. Registrant affirmatively states that Petitioner is barred from asserting this action by reason of statute of limitations on the part of Petitioner.

WHEREFORE, Registrant requests that the cancellation action be dismissed and that the registration at issue be cleared for incontestable status under 15 U.S.C. § 1065 (Section 15 of the Lanham Act).
