PETITION FOR CANCELLATION

Carlson, Caspers, Vandenburgh & Lindquist, P.A. ("Petitioner"), a Minnesota corporation having a principal place of business at 225 South Sixth Street, Suite 3200, Minneapolis, MN 55402, believes that it is and will continue to be damaged by the registration of GO-TO LAW FIRMS (U.S. Registration No. 3,010,062) on the Principal Register and hereby petitions to cancel the same pursuant to the provisions of Lanham Act § 14, 15 U.S.C. § 1064 (2008).

Grounds for Cancellation

- 1. Petitioner is the owner of the mark, THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES, used in connection with consulting and legal services, intellectual property legal services, litigation services, intellectual property litigation services, and printed material in the nature of written legal advice and/or opinions ("Petitioner's Goods and Services").
- 2. Petitioner has used the mark, THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES, in connection with the aforementioned consulting and legal-related services since

at least as early as March 31, 2003, and with written legal advice and/or opinions since at least as early as May 29, 2003.

- 3. Petitioner has maintained continuous use of the mark, THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES, in connection with Petitioner's Goods and Services since the dates listed in Paragraph 2.
- 4. Petitioner has consistently and publicly promoted its inherently distinctive mark, THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES, in connection with its offering of Petitioner's Goods and Services. Petitioner has developed a favorable reputation and valuable goodwill in the mark, THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES, which identifies, distinguishes, and indicates the source of Petitioner's Goods and Services.
- 5. Upon information and belief, Respondent, ALM Media Properties, LLC, is a Delaware limited liability company, with a business address of 120 Broadway, 5th Floor, New York, NY 10271.
- 6. On January 23, 2004, Respondent filed a trademark application, Application Serial No. 76/572,414, for the claimed mark GO-TO LAW FIRMS ("Respondent's Mark") in connection with "legal directories" ("Respondent's Goods"). Respondent's GO-TO LAW FIRMS trademark application, matured into U.S. Reg. No. 3,010,062 ("Respondent's Registration").
 - 7. Respondent's Registration claims a date of first use of October 2003.
- 8. Upon information and belief, October 2003 is the earliest date for which Respondent can establish use of Respondent's Mark in connection with Respondent's Goods.
- 9. Upon information and belief, Respondent surveys in-house counsel at top companies to identify law firms that are most often used by corporate counsel for legal assistance in numerous fields, which have included: (1) Intellectual Property, and (2) Litigation, among

others. Selected law firms are then named, for example, a "Go-To Law Firm® for Intellectual Property" or a "Go-To Law Firm® for Litigation" and they are encouraged and authorized by Respondent to market and publicize this mark, title, recognition, and award to the public, including those interested in purchasing legal services.

- 10. Upon information and belief, Respondent also has surveyed top technology companies and awarded the title, "Go-To Law Firm® For Technology Companies" and encouraged and authorized recipient law firms to market and publicize this mark, title, recognition, and award to the public, including those interested in purchasing legal services.
- 11. Petitioner began using the mark, THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES, for the aforementioned consulting and legal-related services, at least six months prior to Respondent's alleged date of first use and more than nine months before Respondent's application filing date. Petitioner began using it's mark in connection with written legal opinions at least four months prior to Respondent's alleged date of first use and more than seven months before Respondent's application filing date.
- 12. Petitioner's common law rights in THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES mark have priority over Respondent's Mark and Respondent's Registration.
- 13. Respondent's GO-TO LAW FIRMS mark is highly similar to Petitioner's THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES mark. Both contain the distinctive and dominant term GO-TO in connection with legal-related goods and services.
- 14. Respondent's Goods overlap with or are closely related to Petitioner's Goods and Services.
- 15. Respondent's GO-TO LAW FIRMS mark is likely, when used on or in connection with Respondent's Goods, to cause confusion, mistake, or deception with Petitioner's THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES mark used in connection with

Petitioner's Goods and Services. Consumers of legal products and services are likely to mistakenly believe that the goods Respondent offers under the GO-TO LAW FIRMS mark are sponsored, endorsed, or approved by Petitioner, or are in some other way affiliated, connected, or associated with Petitioner, all to the detriment of Petitioner.

- 16. Respondent's use of highly similar non-distinctive designations such as "Intellectual Property," "Litigation," and "Technology Companies," in close proximity and immediately following the GO-TO LAW FIRMS mark aggravates the likelihood of confusion.
- 17. Petitioner has been damaged, in part, because Respondent's Registration should not have been permitted under Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act, given Petitioner's prior use of, and common law rights in, its prior and senior mark, THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES.
- 18. Petitioner is further damaged because Respondent's awarding of the title, "Go-To Law Firm" for specific legal specialties, namely "Intellectual property," "Litigation," and "Technology companies" creates further likely confusion with Petitioner's mark and damages Petitioner's ability to fully enjoy the benefits of its prior mark, THE GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES, without a resulting likelihood of confusion.
- 19. Petitioner is further damaged by reverse confusion resulting from Respondent's Registration and use of the GO-TO LAW FIRMS mark as this junior use has saturated the market and overwhelmed Petitioner and its senior use of the GO-TO FIRM FOR PATENT-SAVVY COMPANIES, causing Petitioner to lose the value of its trademark/service mark and the control over its goodwill and reputation.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Board grant its petition for cancellation of U.S. Reg. No. 3,010,062 pursuant to § 14 of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1064.
