**MULTI ACCESS LIMITED’S MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE TO SERVE
REBUTTAL DISCLOSURES PENDING DISPOSITION OF REGISTRANT’S
MOTION TO STRIKE PORTIONS OF PETITIONER’S NOTICE OF RELIANCE**

Pursuant to Section 509.01 of the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board Manual of Procedure (TBMP), Petitioner, Multi Access Limited (“Multi Access”) respectfully requests that the Board extend the deadline to serve Petitioner’s Rebuttal Disclosures pending disposition of Registrant’s Motion to Strike Portions of Petitioner’s Notice of Reliance. In support of this motion, Petitioner states as follows:

1. On May 17, 2013, Registrant filed a Motion to Strike Portions of Petitioner’s Notice of Reliance filed with the Board and served on Registrant on March 25, 2013 (Dkt. 36).

2. On June 3, 2013, Petitioner timely opposed Registrant’s motion (Dkt. 37). In so opposing, Multi Access filed and served a Second Supplemental Notice of Reliance to address alleged defects in the Notice of Reliance filed and served on March 25, 2013

(Dkt. 18) in the event that the Board concluded that the original Notice of Reliance failed to comply with the requirements for Rule 2.122(e).

3. The Board's Order resetting trial dates entered April 18, 2013 set a deadline for Defendant's 30-day trial period to close on June 17, 2013 (Dkt. 34). Registrant did not produce any evidence or offer any testimony during this trial period. However, Petitioner's rebuttal disclosures are currently due to be served tomorrow, July 2, 2013.

4. Pending the Board's disposition of Registrant's Motion to Strike and/or to the extent that Registrant seeks to offer additional evidence and/or testimony in response thereto, Petitioner respectfully requests that it be afforded an opportunity to introduce appropriate rebuttal disclosures at that time.

Wherefore, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Board entering an order suspending the proceeding or otherwise extending the deadline to serve Petitioner's Rebuttal Disclosures.


