This written statement should take the form of a "certificate of service" which should read as follows:

The undersigned hereby certifies that a copy of the attached [insert title of document] has been served, by first class mail, upon respondent at the following address: [insert name and address].

The certificate of service must be signed and dated.

The Board may decline to consider any motion or paper filed by petitioner in this proceeding which does not include the required proof of service. In order to expedite this matter, a copy of the filing is forwarded herewith to respondent's counsel.²
