In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations, proceedings will resume on August 1, 2015 without further

notice or order from the Board and will proceed upon the schedule set forth in Respondent's motion.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rules 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

If, during the suspension period, either of the parties or their attorneys should have a change of address, the Board should be so informed.¹
