On May 28, 2014, in response to the Board's May 27, 2014 order, respondent filed a proposed amendment to its Registration No. 4218400, with petitioner's consent.¹

By the proposed amendment respondent seeks to amend the identification of goods in International Class 25.

From: Belts; bikinis; dresses; jackets; pants; shirts; shoes; shorts

To: Special occasion apparel, namely, belts; dresses; jackets; pants; shirts; shoes

Inasmuch as the amendment complies with the requirements of Trademark Rule 2.173, is limiting in nature, and petitioner consents thereto, the amendment is approved. *See* Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The amendment will be forwarded to the Post Registration Branch of this Office for entry of the amendment in accordance with Section 7(e) of the Trademark Act.²

If the amendment resolves this proceeding, petitioner is allowed until thirty days from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the petition to cancel, failing which the petition to cancel will go forward on the registration as amended. *See* Trademark Rule 2.114(c).

If no response is filed, proceedings will be resumed and dates reset, as appropriate. Proceedings are otherwise suspended.
