## STIPULATED MOTION FOR SUSPENSION OF CANCELLATION PROCEEDING

Petitioner, The Cellular Connection, LLC, hereby requests suspension of Cancellation No. 92065038, with consent of Respondent, Alandra L. Washington.

A cancellation proceeding may be suspended for good cause upon motion or stipulation of the parties. Trademark Trial and Appeal Board Manual of Procedure § 510.03(a). The parties' agreement to suspend proceedings for consideration of a matter by an examining attorney, including the disposition of a party's application before the examining attorney, has been found to constitute such "good cause."
