While the alert doesn't mean you shouldn't travel to the continent, there are certain safety tips you should keep in mind.

"Throughout history, it is the larger public areas that get attacked because they want to achieve maximum impact," said John Rose, aviation and terrorism expert and COO of travel risk management company, iJET.

According to Rose, transportation is one of the easiest targets for attacks because you have large groups of people coming in who are harder to remember and are less likely to spot unusual patterns.

Rose recommends that travelers avoid crowded cars when on the subway and that they consider the safety record and airports of their destinations.

"I would stick to American-based airlines or their partners because you know that they are flying with certain safety and security standards," said Daniel Durazo, Director of Communications for Allianz Global Assistance USA.

Durazo also recommends avoiding connecting flights or stopovers in places that may have terrorism hotspots or other safety concerns. A travel agent can be a beneficial source when it comes to planning complex itineraries.



Consider the safety record of your airline and the stopover destinations of your flight.

Because you want to avoid large crowds, Rose also suggests visiting tourist attractions at their off-peak hours instead of popular times.

Traveller Enrollment Program (STEP), which provides information
from the Embassy on safety conditions in your destination
and helps both the US Embassy and your family or friends contact
you in the case of an emergency.

You'll also want to prepare before your trip with a briefing of where you'll be going, the routes you'll be taking while you're there, and the safety and security protocols of the country.

Finally, both Durazo and Rose recommend stocking your phone with safety apps. Both iJET and Allianz have apps, with iJET's Worldcue Mobile app providing quick connection to global hotlines and the precise location of people at risk, and Allianz's TravelSmart app giving information on numbers to dial in cases of emergencies and an international hospital search for the closest facilities.



Other apps include the SAIP app put out by the French government to provide real-time security alerts and emergency information ahead of the UEFA European Championship.

"The State Department puts these warnings and alerts out to educate people that there may be a potential situation in the continent, so you should still go on your trip but just be aware and have plan so that if something should happen, you'll know what to do," Durazo said.

"It helped me out in numerous situations," says Merckens, the chief technology officer for a technology firm based in Las Vegas.

Travel insurance apps, which used to be simple programs that helped you contact an insurance company or file a claim, are coming of age. The best travel insurance apps for your next trip offer real-time access to medical and emergency travel assistance, extensive embassy and hospital contact information, and even the ability to buy insurance on the fly.



A stable and useful travel insurance app can make the difference between a bumpy trip and a smooth one. With the busy summer travel just underway, it's an excellent time to consider what may be an important feature of your travel insurance policy.

someone keep track of their policies and helping claims get processed faster," says Kimberlee Leonard, an insurance analyst for FitSmallBusiness.com. Leonard says one example of a travel insurance app that does more is the Allianz TravelSmart Mobile App.

"TravelSmart has a medical translation feature," she says. "Even if someone is fluent enough in a foreign language to get around, most people will not know complex medical terms and explanations. This tool could literally be a lifesaver when working with medical providers in emergency situations."





Exploring one of the best travel insurance apps

No one officially tracks the most popular travel insurance apps, but with more than 470,000 downloads, TravelSmart appears to be one of the most popular.

"One of the things people love about travel is the discovery of new places and people," says Daniel Durazo, a spokesman for Allianz. "TravelSmart helps travelers navigate unfamiliar territory and gives people the confidence to travel off the beaten path.

I'm a regular user of TravelSmart since I have an annual Allianz travel insurance policy. (It's free to download and available to anyone, regardless of whether they're an Allianz customer.) Mostly, I use it to file claims — I've had a few smaller ones earlier this year after suffering a minor medical condition on a trip to New Mexico and Arizona.

I was surprised to find that there's more to the app than filing claims. It includes:

- An international medical dictionary and first-aid terms translator.
- Real-time flight status updates, available up to three days before your flight.
- The ability to access your policy and file and track claims when you're logged into your account.



Perhaps the coolest new feature is the "Assistance Around Me" map, which uses geolocation to direct travelers to the closest hospital, clinic, pharmacy, police station or U.S. embassy. It offers turn-by-turn directions using a choice of Google or Apple maps. Allianz Travel flags recommended hospitals within the app so you can identify vetted facilities quickly.

The next version of TravelSmart, which should be available later this year, will also send safety alerts with information about travel issues at your location, including severe weather, civil protests, terrorism, transit strikes and other problems that may affect travel.

Here are some other terrific travel insurance apps

In addition to Allianz, here is a list of the best travel insurance apps for your next trip (note that some of these are limited to policyholders):

AIG Travel Assistance App

The AIG Travel Assistance App, available only to corporate account holders and certain other policyholders, offers many of the features you're looking for, including access to in-depth travel, security and health information. Feature availability depends on the type of policy you buy. Merckens, the chief technology officer, used the AIG app. "It's the best travel insurance mobile app I've used," he says.

Chubb Travel Smart

Chubb Travel Smart, also available only to select policyholders, uses state-of-art information mining technology to enable quick identification and communication of potential threats based on your location or planned destination. It aggregates and filters information from thousands of different sources globally, including news media, government institutions, security and health information databases and social media. Goose

This app, launched in Canada last year, takes a novel approach to travel insurance. It allows you to buy travel medical insurance in under 60 seconds through the app. You can purchase policies by the day or for longer periods, and up to seven days after a vacation has begun. "We know that if travel insurance is more accessible and affordable, Canadians will opt in and avoid thousands of dollars in medical bills during a travel emergency," said Dejan Mirkovic, founder of Goose Insurance Services, at the time of the app's launch in 2018. Goose works similarly to its U.S. counterparts, offering an in-app map and '911-equivalent' list that gives you instant access to local emergency services. Goose is only available to Canadian



 The crux of the issue has to do with whether more rescue spending will help or hurt an economy that's on the road to recovery but clearly has a long way to go.

 New estimates from the Congressional Budget Office show that extending the extra \$600 unemployment benefits—a major point of contention between Democrats and Republicans—until January would boost the economy in the short term but stifle growth in 2021.

- The CBO says the benefits would reduce incentives to work for those who take home more from unemployment than they would otherwise earn, and that has the potential to depress both output and employment.
- On the other hand, former Obama administration economist Ernie Tedeschi told the Washington Post that letting those benefits run out next month would be akin to delivering a "50 to 75 percent pay cut overnight to a huge chunk of the American population."

Others took Friday's jobs numbers as a sign that stimulus measures have worked. "This is good news and we should be happy that the unemployment rate is coming down and jobs are being added," tweeted Jason Furman, chair of the White House Council of Economic Advisers under President Obama. "In part it reflects the fact that stimulus is working. We need more of it!"



Tedeschi has echoed that sentiment. "The best interpretation I have for this right now is that when we had the April report, virtually none of the stimulus had gone out by the reference week," he told the *New York Times*. "Now we've had a full month of fiscal support. I think part of the recovery is due to that."

KEY BACKGROUND

Since the crisis began, lawmakers have passed four pieces of rescue legislation. The first two bills—which shored up funding for testing and small business loans, established tax credits for paid sick leave, and expanded unemployment benefits—were followed by the historic \$2.2 trillion CARES Act. That's the bill that created the Paycheck Protection Program and authorized the IRS to send out the first round of stimulus checks. The CARES Act was succeeded by another \$484 billion package that replenished funding for emergency assistance for small businesses after the PPP exhausted its initial \$350 billion in funding after less than two weeks. Act — a \$3 trillion relief package designed by House Democrats led by Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-Calif.)— passed the House last month but was widely criticized by Republicans, who said it was an unrealistic, partisan offering that was drafted without any Republican input and that it will be "DOA" in the Senate. Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell (R-Ky.) said last month that the next round of stimulus legislation will be the "final" bill Congress passes, and that it will be narrower in scope than the CARES Act.

Oil companies are shelling out as much as 75% more to renew insurance liability coverage for directors and officers, as the sector prepares for a wave of bankruptcies brought on by collapsing oil and gas demand and plunging prices during the





Companies at risk of insolvency have been looking to purchase additional insurance to cover claims against directors and officers in cases where the company cannot do so, known as a 'Side A' policy, according to brokers.

"Oil and gas companies were not thinking "How much insurance should I buy if both debtors and equity holders come after me?" at their last renewal," said Jon Janes, an insurance director at Willis Towers Watson.

These policies can prevent directors from having to pay out of pocket if their company becomes insolvent or in judgment of a shareholder derivative lawsuit.

Companies take out directors and officers insurance as courts in the past have found executives liable in class-action suits for poor governance or failed mergers.

Numerous oil-and-gas producers have been cutting spending while others have declared bankruptcy as prices cratered in recent months.

Insurers are adding creditor exclusions and some exclusions specific to COVID-19 to some policies, Sebastian Swain, a director at CRC Insurance Services, said.

Among the most notable Chapter 11 filings so far have been Whiting Petroleum Corp. and Diamond Offshore Drilling Inc., both of which filed in April. Shale pioneer Chesapeake Energy Corp. said in May it has no access to capital and is considering a bankruptcy filing.

The industry is particularly watching for any Chapter 7 bankruptcies, said Matthew Raymer, vice president in management & professional solutions at Alliant Insurance Services, noting these are generally associated with class-action lawsuits

"The energy sector has performed better than average when it comes to class-action lawsuits in years past," he said. "But these are unprecedented times."

Good faith coverage disputes over pandemic-related business interruption coverage don't have to be fought out in courts, and retroactive rewrites of business interruption coverage language are unfair, according to a plaintiffs lawyer who represents restaurants.

John Houghtaling, II, a lawyer for Gauthier Murphy & Houghtaling, in Louisiana who represents the Business Interruption Group, told Carrier Management last week that the idea of a federal subsidy program, which would reimburse insurers that Voluntarily pay pandemic-related business interruption claims filed under policies with virus exclusions, is a win-win proposition that he believes will soon be introduced as a draft legislation.

Houghtaling, who also proposed such a program at a House <u>Small Business</u> <u>committee virtual forum</u> back on May 21, agrees that there has been some confusion about what the proposal is all about. 'We expect to have bipartisan support in the House and Senate from those that understand it. However, there is a big misunderstanding. We're hopeful that once it's introduced, there is an understanding

During a half-hour phone interview last week, he corrected some misconceptions about the proposal and said that he fully expected a Democratic congressman to introduce a bill based on the idea in the near future. (Carrier Management had not received confirmation of impending introduction from the potential bill sponsor at press time.)

What It Says

In a nutshell, the BIG proposal would allow insurers to opt into a program under which

arguments for and against coverage.

In Houghtaling's mind, battles over ambiguous language shouldn't enrich plaintiffs lawyers or defense lawyers.

"My proposal is that if an insurance company has put the word virus somewhere into the policy, and is arguing that that's excluding everything for a pandemic, then that carrier is not compelled to but can voluntarily pay it now and receive reimbursement for the claim amount and the claim expenses," he said.

"What we're offering is cheaper for government, for businesses, for employees, and for insurance companies. It will be better for the government to have these companies stay in the economy than to go bust. It will be better for employees not to be on unemployment line, but to have their jobs. It will be better for the insurance companies to have an out—to have some subsidy for this, rather than turning it over to the expensive lawyers. It'll be better for the businesses to have the limited coverage."


No one is getting shortchanged or overcompensated with this plan, he said, explaining that a business interruption policy is "exactly measured" to what businesses need. "Your payroll is in there as a line item. "You rent is in there as a line item... You pay dollar premiums for certain amount of coverage, which is just necessary to keep your lights on. So it's a proper measure," he said. By contrast, a lot of relief programs fall short "because there's been windfalls for companies that don't need it. There's nothing for companies that do."

Houghtaling continued: "If all this gets turned over to fighting lawyers, the lawyers make the money, And I've got to tell you, it is against my own self-interest because I am one. But in this particular case, I am going to be litigating over the ashes of my best friends in my life who happen to be in the restaurant and hospitality business," he said.

"Part of the responsibility for the shutdown is the government. Part of the [problem] may be from the insurance companies not being clear on their contracts and not using the word pandemic when they should have. Let's come with an equitable solution that will be cheaper," he said.

What It Doesn't Say

Insurers that have clear language in their policies wouldn't be included in the proposed federal reimbursement program. Houghtaling said.

"If you clearly excluded pandemics, you excluded pandemics. If you use the word pandemic and you excluded it, it's obvious. You're out," he said, noting that insurers don't need any assistance for coverage denials in these cases

"If you don't have any exclusion for viruses or pandemics or anything, you're not part

"It's the ones in the middle where it may be ambiguous, and there's going to be litigation over," he said. "As long as the word virus is in the policy that excludes some coverage, we wouldn't have a debate where it applies or what it applies to."

"It's policy specific, not company specific," he said, when asked about insurers that wrote some policies that contain virus exclusions and other policies where insurers simply contend that language requiring direct physical loss of or damage to property from a covered cause of loss supports claims denials.

"It would not apply to where there's no mention of pandemic or virus in it whatsoever....The program would not be appropriate to that-this is the way we view it—because that's not an argument. It's a baloney argument," he said, referring to carriers' contention that COVID-19 doesn't impact property. "It's not a true argument. It's a lie. And it's not going to go anywhere in the courts. This is going to be decided very quickly. I filed the first declaratory judgment [action] in the world on this issue," he

"My feeling is it's inappropriate to subsidize an insurance company that has collected policy premiums when they clearly owe [coverage]. It is also inappropriate to subsidize for policies that clearly exclude it," he said. The program is "for the ones where there's some ambiguity. It applies where there's a good faith dispute.

Still, there is document on BIG's website that describes the proposal as follows "Those that opt in must pay B.I. [business interruption] claims on policies without virus exclusions. If they do so, insurers can apply and receive reimbursement on B.I. claims and claims expense that are subject to virus exclusion." (emphasis added)

Houghtaling explained that the first sentence has been reconsidered in the latest workup of the BIG proposal

"We were thinking initially about not allowing an insurance company to go into a program unless they paid all the other policies," he said. The revised thinking says "Let's forget about that because it's too hard to force somebody to do something. Let's

For the insurers hanging their hats on "direct physical loss of or damage to property" language to say they don't have to pay claims, "let them hire a lawyer and waste money on lawyers and get their clock cleaned. But the ones where you have an ambiguous situation should be able to opt in.

Summing up, Houghtaling said: "What the insurance industry should do is to pay the policies that they owe; they should deny the policies they don't owe." In betwee those extremes, "if there are ones that they fight about, that we can have arguments on both sides [about], what we're suggesting is let's solve this issue now." The alternative is spending years in court and billions of dollars on legal fees "after people have been put on unemployment lines, [businesses] have gone bankrupt" with the domino effect of mortgage and lease defaults rippling through the economy.

Not Retroactive: Not Prospective

The lawyer, who has filed cases on behalf of Oceana Grill against Lloyd's and on behalf of Thomas Keller Restaurant Group against The Hartford, said that lawmakers who had been seeking to retroactively knock out exclusions in existing policies now realize this can't go backwards.

Other proposals seek to deal with pandemic-related business interruption coverage prospectively, he said, seemingly referring to the Pandemic Risk Insurance Act introduced by Rep. Carolyn Maloney (D-NY) a few weeks ago, and the Business Continuity Protection Program, supported by insurance industry trade groups. Although he did not mention either by name, he said a prospective plan is something "that doesn't help us now. It's leaving this problem in the middle of what do we do for people now that have bought these policies that believe that they apply—where they may apply but we've got to litigate them?"

"The insurance industry is coming up with arguments. Some may have merit; some have no merit. For example, COVID-19 doesn't impact property. That is hogwash... Contamination, where I can't use something, is a loss to property in all the case law.

Houghtaling is particularly incensed by situations like the one he says client Keller faces, having bought a policy that "actually has a virus inclusion. Not only does it not exclude pandemics or viruses, but it has affirmative coverage for cleanup, and they're denying him," the lawyer contends. "They're denying policies that not only are all-risk policies that have no exclusion, that have specific civil authority coverage, but they're actually denying policies that have affirmative coverage.

For policies that where contamination cleanup is a covered cause of loss, he contends, civil authority coverage is triggered. "It triggers the entirety of the other coverages. You have to look at the words of the contract," he said.

"The insurance industry keeps saying, 'Don't change our policies,' but they're misrepresenting what the policies say. That's the part that I find to be morally reprehensible," he said.



Houghtaling said he agrees with a lot of the "I agree with the insurance industry what the industry has to say, using the testimony of Sean Kevelighan, CEO of Insurance Information Institute, to highlight areas of agreement he had with Kevelighan when both men testified at the Small Business committee virtual forum last month. "We agree that we should not retroactively change policies." he said, referring to Kevelighan's assertions that "any efforts to retroactively rewrite business interruption policies are not only unconstitutional, but would imperil the insurance industry's ability to pay [other] covered insurance claims. "We agree that


policyholders and the insurers should live by the terms of them," he said, hoting that Kevelighan also said that some policies, which do not exclude viruses, should be enforced as written.

"The only stark disagreement is one of fact, which is that the insurance industry is denying that the coronavirus contaminates property," he added.

"What we're trying to do is to have something that is pro-consumer and pro-insurance company."

"We're not against the insurance industry.....We're not asking for policies to be changed," he said.






