political history of the United States; Educational toys for teaching math principles to children, namely, manipulative blocks for displaying patterns and groupings; Educational toys for teaching music principles to children, namely, hand-held music notation symbols and music related figures, such as individual hand-held piano keys; Educational toys in the nature of an illustrated wall map; Electric toy train transformers; Electric action toys; Electric educational toy used to demonstrate alternative energy sources; Electronic toy building blocks that light up as a night light; Electronic toy vehicles; Electronic action toys; Electronic learning toys; Electronically operated toy motor vehicles; Fantasy character toys; Flying toys using electrostatic levitation; Flying saucers; Gift baskets comprised primarily of toy imitation sporting goods, namely, toy game balls and accessories therefor; Gift baskets comprised primarily of imitation toys sports products, namely, toy game balls and accessories therefor; Gift baskets containing plush toys; Hand-powered non-mechanical flying toy; Helical spring toys; Infant toys; Infant action crib toys; Infant development toys; Inflatable toys; Inflatable toys showing decorative pictures; Inflatable bath toys; Inflatable pool toys; Inflatable ride-on toys; Inflatable thin rubber toys; Interchangeable magnetic toy vehicles; Interlocking construction toys; Kinetic motion desk toys; Lever action toys; Mechanical toys; Mechanical action toys; Miniature toy helmets; Miniature toy sports games; Model toy steam engines; Model toy steam operated traction engines; Model toy vehicles; Modeled plastic toy figurines; Molded toy figures; Music box toys; Musical toys; Non-electronic toy vehicles; Non-riding transportation toys; Novelty toy item in the nature of a dispenser of stream material; Novelty toy items in the nature of pop ups; Novelty toy items, namely, fake teeth; Novelty toys for playing jokes; Novelty noisemaker toys for parties; Novelty plush toys for parties; Party favors in the nature of small toys; Perpetual motion desk toys; Pet

toys; Pet toys containing catnip; Pet toys made of rope; Plastic toy hoops; Plastic character toys; Play houses and toy accessories therefor; Play mats containing infant toys; Play mats for use with toy vehicles; Playing pieces in the nature of miniature action figures and toy model vehicles for use with table top hobby battle games in the nature of battle, war and skirmish games, and fantasy games; Plush toys; Plush toys with attached comfort blanket; Pop up toys; Portable musical toysincorporating telecommunication functions; Positionable toy figures; Positionable printed toy figures for use in games; Positionable printed toy figures for use in puzzles; Positionable three dimensional toys for use in games; Positionable two dimensional toys for use in games; Printed positionable toys for use in children's board games; Printing toys; Pull toys; Punching toys; Push toys; PVC toy figures; Racks and stands specifically designed to hold toy scooters; Racks and stands specifically designed to hold toy vehicles; Radio controlled toy vehicles; Radio transmitters for use with radio-controlled toys; Radio-controlled toy vehicles; Remote-controlled toy vehicles; Ride-on toys; Ride-on toys and accessories therefor; Rideable toy vehicles; Rideable toys and accessories therefor; Rubber character toys; Sand toys; Sandbox toys; Scale model kits; Sketching toys; Smart electronic toy vehicles; Smart plush toys; Smart robot toys; Soft sculpture toys; Soft sculpture plush toys; Spinning fidget toys; Squeezable squeaking toys; Squeeze toys; Stacking toys; Stands for rideable toys; Stress relief exercise toys; Stuffed toy animals; Stuffed toy bears; Stuffed toys; Stuffed and plush toys; Talking toys; Talking electronic press-down toy; Tesselation toys; Tossing disc toys; Transforming robotic toy vehicles; Transforming robotic toys; Two and three dimensional positionable toy figures sold as a unit with educational books; Two and three dimensional positionable toy figures sold as a unit with memory training equipment.; Two and three dimensional positionable toy figures sold as a

unit with other toys; Two and three dimensional positionable figures sold as an integral component of toys; Vending machine toys; Visors for toy helmets; Water toys; Water squirting toys; Water-squirting toys; Wheels for toy vehicles; Wind-up toys; Wind-up walking toys.

- (8) On March 7, 2019, Plaintiff's application was refused registration solely with reference to the goods in International Class 28, the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) citing Defendant's registration as the basis for the refusal.
- (9) Given that Defendant's registration is being relied upon to refuse registration to Plaintiff's application for the goods in International Class 28, Plaintiff has standing to pursue cancellation of Defendant's registration.
- (10) Plaintiff has been in the business of selling gifts including stuffed animals since at least as early as 1984. In so doing, Plaintiff has used the expression "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR" in various forms since 1984 and to date. Plaintiff's use of the expression "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR" as a trademark predates Defendant's claimed date of first use by well over 30 years. Since the USPTO has concluded there is a likelihood of confusion between Defendant's mark and the mark "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR" for which registration is sought in Plaintiff's application, the converse is also true, in particular, Defendant's mark creates a likelihood of confusion with respect to Plaintiff's mark "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR" in its various forms as reflected in the registrations and application set forth above. Accordingly, Defendant's registration should be canceled under Section 2(d) of the Trademark Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).
- (11) Preliminary to preparing this Petition to Cancel, Plaintiff conducted an investigation. The investigation determined that Defendant was terminated as a corporation by

the Secretary of State of Vermont on or about April 1, 2019. See Exhibit 1, papers printed from the Corporations Division of the Secretary of State of Vermont.

- (12) Plaintiff also conducted a search of the Internet to determine whether Defendant has any presence on the Internet. Attached is the result of a search on www.google.com using the search term "vermont toy company." See Exhibit 2. Exhibit 2 reveals no evidence of any existence of Defendant on the Internet.
- (13) Exhibit 2 also evidences that none of the dozens upon dozens of goods listed in Defendant's registration certificate are actually for sale via the Internet. As such, Plaintiff believes Defendant's mark is abandoned and since Defendant no longer exists as an entity, and the USPTO records do not evidence any assignment of ownership of Defendant's mark, Plaintiff believes Defendant cannot provide any evidence of an intent to resume use of Defendant's mark.

GROUNDS FOR CANCELLATION

- 1. PRIOR USE AND LIKELIHOOD OF CONFUSION UNDER SECTION 2(d) OF THE TRADEMARK ACT, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d)
- (14) Plaintiff incorporates by reference paragraphs (1) (13) as if stated herein.
- (15) Plaintiff owns Registration Nos. 1,941,985; 2,201,144; 2,201,145 and 5,427,606, each of which includes, in pertinent part, the literal element "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR."

 These marks have been used in interstate commerce in some cases since at least as early as February 1984, and continuously to date.
- (16) Plaintiff owns the mark "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR" in standard characters as set forth in Plaintiff's application. This mark has been used in interstate commerce since at least as early as April 1985, and continuously to date.

- (17) Defendant's mark has allegedly been used in interstate commerce since January 22, 2018. As such, Plaintiff's use of its marks which incorporate the literal element "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR" has occurred over 30 years prior to Defendant's use of Defendant's mark.
- (18) Accordingly, Plaintiff asserts that it is the prior user of marks including the literal element "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR" and that Defendant's mark (VERMONT TOY COMPANY) creates a likelihood of confusion vis a vis Plaintiff's marks incorporating the literal element "VERMONT TEDDY BEAR."
- (19) As such, Defendant's registration should be canceled under Section 2(d) of the Trademark Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

2. ABANDONMENT UNDER 15 U.S.C. § 1127

- (20) Plaintiff incorporates by reference paragraphs (1) (19) as if stated herein.
- (21) Plaintiff has uncovered no evidence that Defendant is using Defendant's mark in interstate commerce in association with any of the goods listed in its certificate of registration.
- (22) Accordingly, Plaintiff submits that Defendant's mark is abandoned under 15 U.S.C. § 1127.
- (23) Defendant ceased existence on or about April 1, 2019. The assignment records of the USPTO reflect no assignment having been executed prior to April 1, 2019 or, in fact, thereafter. As such, Defendant cannot demonstrate any intention to resume use.
- (24) 15 U.S.C. § 1127 states that "Intent not to resume may be inferred from circumstances." Plaintiff submits that where Defendant no longer exists as an entity, the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board can infer that there is no intention to resume use.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Based upon the facts and circumstances set forth above, Plaintiff requests that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board cancel Registration No. 5,677,084 for the mark "VERMONT TOY COMPANY."


